How the program works—here is what you do!

- Create your online fundraising page to share with your sponsors! If created by day 7, you will win a Read for RMHC-CR bracelet! You can also track your sponsors on your sponsor form.
- Students ask family and friends to sponsor your reading for the month (either a flat amount for all reading accomplished during the month, or a specific amount of money pledged per minute read during the month).

When your reading month begins:

• On **November 1**, students start reading. You may keep a record of your minutes spent reading on your reading calendar. Minutes can be entered in the calendar electronically and saved on the computer or you may print the calendar to write in minutes. Minutes when others read to you count too, so be sure to count them! After your reading month has ended:

- Gather your donations either online or return them to school by the deadline set by the school December 5th. Reading calendars do not need to be returned to RMHC. Please return cash or check donations with a completed sponsor form. Students with online donations only do not need to turn in sponsor forms.
- All student participants receive a personalized participation certificate.
- Students who read and raise donations receive Read for RMHC-CR prizes and an invitation to tour RMHC.
- Congratulate yourself on a job well done helping kids just like you!
