- A citizen of the United States of America
- At least 18 (eighteen) years of age to qualify for office
- Able to read and write
- A resident of Pine Hill for at least one year
- Not disqualified as a voter pursuant to NJSA 19:4-1
- A registered voter in the district
- Not convicted of a disqualifying crime pursuant to NJSA 18A:12-1
- Have no personal interest in any contract with, or claim against the Board
- Not simultaneously hold (2) two elective offices
- Must not hold office as mayor or member of the municipal governing body or, in the case of county school districts, the county governing body
- Within 30 days of election or appointment to the board, a member must undergo a criminal history background investigation through the state Department of Education.
