Consultation and collaboration Form	Brian Siesto	10 min	Brian asked and received five volunteers from Building Council to sign the annual Consultation and Collaboration Form.
Capital Project	Brian Siesto	20 min	Approximately one year ago, the Victor Central School District began discussing a proposed Capital Project. The current enrollment of over 1300 students exists on a physical campus footprint that has not changed in 8-10 years. The projected change would be to build a single floor wing across the front of the Junior and Senior High Schools. This would include 16 additional classrooms to potentially serve special education and computer science needs. New York State has delayed their approval as it takes a year to get potential bids. If approved by taxpayers, the 2 year project is expected to be completed by September 2027. Additional parking and traffic patterns will also be addressed.
