

## Monona Grove Pool Rules

1. Children under the age of 8 must be within arm's reach of an adult 18 years or older at all times.
2. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by an adult 18 years or older in the facility at all times.\*
3. Diving is only allowed in 7 ft. water, off the south end of the pool (between the starting blocks). No diving in the shallow end or along the sides of the pool.
4. No breath holding allowed.\*
5. No playing on or jumping from the pool ledge/railing along lane 8 (deep end with no railing is okay).
6. No horseplay, running, shoving or dunking. Behavior that endangers the safety and wellbeing of yourself and/or other patrons will not be allowed.\*
7. Profane language is not allowed.
8. All patrons must shower before entering the pool and after using the restroom.\*
9. Patrons having contagious or infectious health conditions and/or open wounds will not be allowed in the pool per the discretion of the lifeguard.\*
10. Patrons under the influence of alcohol or other drugs will not be allowed in the pool or on the grounds.\*
11. Long hair must be restrained (swim cap or tied back).
12. All patrons must wear appropriate swim attire. No cut-off shorts, clothing with rivets, buttons and/or zippers allowed.
13. Patrons who are not toilet-trained are required to wear swim diapers or rubber pants (over cloth diapers) in addition to a swim suit.
14. No shoes on the pool deck.\*
15. Animals are not permitted in the pool area.\*
16. Food, drink, gum and tobacco products are not permitted on the pool deck.\*
17. Glass containers are not permitted in the facility.\*
18. Absolutely no swimming without a lifeguard on duty.
19. All patrons must follow the directives of and be respectful of the lifeguard or instructor in charge. Failure to do so will result in the patron being asked to leave.
20. Use of the diving blocks outside of swim lessons or coach-supervised swim practice is not allowed.
21. Facility staff reserve the right to ask anyone to take a deep water swim test to be able to swim in certain areas of the pool.

## Monona Grove Pool Policies

1. A Lifeguard's primary duty is to respond to emergencies, supervision of children is the parent or guardian's responsibility.
2. Monona Grove Pool maintains the right to open/close/combine classes or programs as necessary.
3. Only Coastguard approved lifejackets are permitted only with in-water supervision.
4. All swim lessons held at MGHS must be held by a staff member or an approved instructor.
5. The Monona Grove Pool locker rooms close 15 minutes after the last activity.
6. The Monona Grove Pool has a No-Refund policy. However, full Refunds will be given if the Monona Grove Pool cancels a class. A prorated refund may be given only if severe illness or injury prevents participation. In the case of an eligible situation for a refund, a Monona Grove Pool credit will be applied. Individuals will not be eligible for a refund if they register their children or themselves for more than one session at a time and have placed their student in an incorrect class or if they choose to cancel out and/or withdraw from a class.
