# **CREDIT WAIVER – HOW TO PROCESS FOR TEC AND CTMC**

This document is an instructional guide for administrators detailing how to process a credit waiver for a TEC or CTMC student who meets the required waiver criteria.

### **<u>1. Review the TEC Course Codes & Credit Distribution Chart</u>**

### 2. Review Student Schedules

- Use the correct COURSE CODES to create STUDENT SCHEDULES
  - \* Do NOT use WAIVER COURSE CODES when scheduling students
  - \* Do NOT use PLACEHOLDER COURSES on student schedules
  - \* Schedule ONE TEC Course Code each period of a student schedule
  - A student <u>MUST</u> be scheduled in the appropriate series of <u>THREE COURSES</u> for their TEC or CTMC program (Refer to the TEC Course Codes & Credit Distribution Chart from Step #1)
    - → EXAMPLE: COURSE CODES required for scheduling: S1 Auto Technology (2<sup>nd</sup> Year)

# 3. Create a Historical Course Grade Record for a Credit Waiver for Student

- Select SHOW CREDIT SUMMARIES
- Review the EARNED column
  - → TIP: Hover over the NUMBER in the EARNED column on the CREDIT SUMMARY to see a breakout of EARNED CREDIT by COURSE
  - → EXAMPLE: Earned Credits for World Language (includes entry for CREDIT WAIVER)
