- Demonstrate an understanding of and love for students as image-bearers of God
- Possess a growth mindset and leadership of their own learning, especially in Biblical and content area knowledge
- Have a deep understanding of and desire to live out Briarwood's mission and vision for the glory of God
- Teach for transformation from a Biblical worldview by emphasizing Christ's preeminence in all things
- Desire to lead and mentor a small group of students, with a focus on Growth, Accountability, and Prayer (GAP)

Job Requirements

- Experience teaching high school and/or junior high science
- Must have a minimum of an earned bachelor's degree from an accredited college/university in education, science or a related field. A master's degree in education/teaching is desired and preferred.
- Provide science instruction from a biblical worldview; experience teaching introductory chemistry, physics, STEM, or robotics is desired and preferred
- Attendance at all regular teaching meetings, training, and events
- Mature, living, and active faith in Jesus Christ, and membership in good standing of a local evangelical church
- Experience and a desire to lead co-curricular activities or other program areas (e.g., coaching a sport, student clubs, committee work, etc.)

- Agreement with the school's <u>Statement of Faith</u> and a lifestyle consistent with the school's <u>Declaration</u> of Moral Integrity.
- Successfully complete a criminal background check and MinistrySafe training; both are renewed every three years.

- Prepare a one-page cover letter that includes the title of the position, a brief introduction, a summary
 of your Christian testimony and church involvement and outline of your key attributes that you feel
 reflect your suitability for this position.
- Prepare a resume, listing all personal contact information, contact details of three references (who we
 will only contact after confirming with you), detailed educational credentials, and relevant work
 experience.
