OUHSD Local Scholarship

Description: Local scholarships offered by the Oroville Union High School District are donated and awarded through the many organizations and individuals who share a vested interest in assisting our youth in transitioning to a College/University/Vocational School. This application is used by multiple organizations for student selection.

Eligibility: (ALL SENIORS ARE ENCOURAGED TO APPLY - NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED)

Application Deadline: This will begin in JANUARY 2025

ScholarshipOwl No Essay Scholarship

Description: This application will help students on the fast-track to success by providing direct access to scholarships they need.

Eligibility: Must be a resident of the US, District of Columbia, or US Territories. Need to be 16 years or older, enrolled in a college or university, or registering from a qualified high school, and be located within the United States.

Application Deadline: October 29, 2024 (Deadline was September)

CollegeXpress Scholarship- \$10,000

Description: Carnegie Dartlet, an educational publisher and higher education marketing agency houses CollegeXpress scholarship where students can connect with the right school, since 1995.

Eligibility: A student must be 13 years or older and of legal residence of the United States. The student must currently be attending high school. College, vocational school, or any accredited post-secondary institution

Application Deadline: October 31st, 2024 (Deadline was September)



[Sallie Mae Scholarship](#)

Description: A \$2,000 scholarship awarded to someone of legal residence within the United States, District of Columbia, and any US Territory age 17 or older at time of entry.

Eligibility: One of the four following must be met

- A) A parent who currently has a child enrolled in an accredited college or University within the United States
- B) A student who is enrolled in an accredited college or University within the United States
- C) A parent who has a child enrolled as a high school senior located in the United States
- D) A student who is enrolled currently as a high school junior or senior who intends to enroll in an accredited college or university, within a year of graduating from high school.

Application Deadline: October 31, 2024 (Deadline was September)

[SP Scholarship](#)

Description: \$2,500 for students without the hassle of filling out paperwork and writing dozens of essays.

Eligibility: Least 13 years old, enrolled in a college or university within the US, and a legal resident of the US or Puerto Rico.

Description: \$25,000 no-essay scholarship will be awarded to an applicant who has a bold profile! To be earnest, determined, and moving is what we are looking for when being bold.

Eligibility: ANY education level, state, field of study, and GPA will be considered for this.

Application Deadline: November 1, 2024 (Deadline was October)

Description: EAB is the market leader in helping colleges find and enroll their right-fit students; Appily is a market leader in helping students find right-fit colleges.

Eligibility: Open to high school 10th, 11th, and first semester, 12th grade students.

Application Deadline: October 31, 2024

[NCWIT Award for aspirations in Computing](#) (\$500)

Description: honors 9th - 12th grade women, genderqueer, and non-binary students for their computing-related achievements and interests, and encourages them to pursue their passions. Award recipients are selected based on their aptitude and aspirations in technology and computing.

Eligibility:

- Women, genderqueer, and non-binary students in grades 9 through 12 are welcome to apply.
- They are 13 years of age or older at the time of account creation.
- They receive parent/guardian approval by the approval deadline OR are 18 years of age or older at the time of application submission.
- They attend a school in the U.S., Puerto Rico, Guam, the U.S. Virgin Islands, or on a U.S. overseas military base.
- They are not an NCWIT employee and have no immediate family relationship with employees, extended staff, contractors, or board members of NCWIT (including spouses, siblings, children, grandchildren, and persons residing in the same household).
- Note that applicants under the age of 18 at the time of application submission will require parent or guardian approval.
- They are a U.S. citizen, permanent resident, or individual who meets the requirements of the substantial presence test.
- They have a U.S. Tax Identification or Social Security Number.
- Applicants may reapply each year; however, National Award Winners are not eligible to win again.
- Regional Affiliate Award programs allow repeat recipients, at their own discretion.

Application Deadline: October 29, 2024



[Chick-fil-A Community Scholars](#) (\$25,000)

Description: Every year, at least twelve (12) \$25,000 scholarships are awarded to students based on academic success, community service and financial need. The Chick-fil-A Community Scholars also participate in the Chick-fil-A Scholars Program, a one-year engagement that includes mentoring and leadership development alongside our Chick-fil-A True Inspiration Scholars.

Eligibility:

- Be a resident in the United States, Puerto Rico or Canada.
- Be a postsecondary undergraduate or graduate student or planning to enroll in undergraduate or graduate study at an accredited two- or four-year college, university or vocational-technical school for the 2024-2025 academic year.
- Be recommended by a teacher, coach, community leader or mentor, addressing the applicant's personal and/or professional achievement. Up to three recommendation letters will be accepted.
- Show demonstrated care through community-service in the twelve (12) months prior to application. You will be asked to share in what ways you were able to make an impact on your community, friends and family.
- Have a minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (or the equivalent). Academic awards and recognition will be considered. Applicants are required to upload a transcript that displays their name, school name, classes taken and GPA.

Application Deadline: October 30, 2024



[Builder's Association Scholarships \(\\$3,500\)](#)

Description: The Builders Scholarship Foundation uses investment income from the scholarship endowment fund to create scholarships for outstanding individuals preparing for a career in construction within the area served by the association (Missouri, Kansas, and the surrounding area)

Eligibility:

- full-time college student at a school in the Heartland of the United States in the Fall 2025 or Spring 2026
- semester studying in a construction-related program (construction management, engineering or architecture)

Application Deadline: October 31, 2024

[Elks National Foundation Scholarship](#)

Description: MVS Scholarships are for students pursuing a four year degree on a full time basis (minimum of 12 semester hours) at a US college or university next school year. Please select Chico Elks Lodge #423 as your sponsoring lodge when prompted on the application.

Eligibility:

- Current high school senior who are citizens of the United States
- Applicants DO NOT have to be related to a member of the Elks
- Male and Female students compete separately

Application Deadline: November 11, 2024
