#### Earned Hours

Includes all college credit courses completed with grades of A, B, C, D, S, CR, and P. #### University Calendar

Central State University changed from a quarter calendar to a semester calendar as of the Fall term 2005.

#### Grade Point Average

The grade point average (GPA) is computed by dividing the sum of all GPA points earned by the total number of credits in all courses for which grades of A, B, C, D, F, Z and FZ have been received.

#### Good Standing

A cumulative grade point average of 2.00 is required to be in good standing. Unless otherwise noted, if a student is in good standing, he/she is eligible to re-enroll.

#### Degrees Earned

Degrees earned will appear on the last page at the end of the transcript.

#### Classification of Students

Freshman – A student who has earned 30 semester credit hours or less.

Sophomore – A student who has earned 31 to 60 semester credit hours.

Junior – A student who has earned 61 to 90 semester credit hours.

Senior – A student who has earned 91 or more semester credit hours.
