Dear Colleagues,

As many of you may remember in the Spring of 2023 it was discovered that an employee, Daniel Clery, had accessed personal information of members of the Kent School community through the School's network. Mr. Clery's employment at Kent School was terminated and his criminal actions were reported to Connecticut State Police. The School actively assisted the State Police in their investigation.

Yesterday evening Jeff Cataldo and I met with a group of victims who were most directly impacted by Mr. Clery's actions. They reminded me of the violation they experienced as individuals, and the harm Mr. Clery has done to the community more broadly.

There will be a Dispositional Hearing concerning Mr. Clery's case on October 30 which Jeff Cataldo and I will attend. I have expressed my thoughts about the extremely negative impact Mr. Clery's behavior has had on the victims and the Kent School community to the Victim Services Advocate assigned to the case, Karen Lucid.

On the call, the victims asked that I share Ms. Lucid's email address with you Karen.Lucid@jud.ct.gov in the event you would like to share your thoughts about the impact of Mr. Clery's actions have had on the victims and/or the community.

You can expect an overview of the measures we have taken to ensure such a breach of trust does not happen again at the next staff and faculty meetings.
