



UNIS Hanoi is authorised by the Ministry of Education in Vietnam, accredited by the Council of International Schools, the Western Association of Schools and Colleges and the International Baccalaureate Organisation. It is administered by the Head of School, Jane McGee and governed by a nine-member Board of Directors.








International Partners S24: International schools all over the world who have registered to take part in MAP in 2023 (Spring).







Distribution of our alumni students around the world




School Community Organisation






Finances


Income and Expenditures
