What is Title I ?

- Title I is a federal grant
- Title I provides financial assistance to local educational agencies and schools with high numbers and percentages of children from low-income families.
- Title I is to help ensure that all children meet challenging state academic standards.
- Title I funds are federal dollars given to states, then Indiana issues the money to school districts.

Title I Focus:

- Title I focuses on servicing children who are failing, or most at risk of failing to meet state academic standards
- Title I targeted assistance school programs serve only those students who are at risk of failing
- Title I funds for school-wide programs serve all students in the school
- All MCS schools are school-wide Title I schools

Title I Purpose

- The purpose of Title I is for all children have a fair, equal, and significant opportunity to obtain a high quality education

Title I Goals

- To meet the educational needs of low-achieving students
- To provide enriched and accelerated educational programs, including reading, writing, math and STEM achievement
- To ensure high-quality academic assessments
- To close the achievement gap between students from various backgrounds
