**Scholarship History:** The Rajendran Family Foundation Scholarship Fund for a graduating senior from a Davenport Public High School was established in 2022 by Dr. Vijay Rajendran and his wife Parameswarie, to encourage students with a financial need to attend a 2-year, 4-year or accredited trade school. Dr. Rajendran, a cardiologist with Cardiovascular Medicine PC, and his wife also fund a Pleasant Valley High School scholarship giving consideration to female applicants to encourage participation in the biological sciences.

**Eligibility:** Applicants must have graduated from a Davenport Community School District high school by June 30<sup>th</sup>, while maintaining an overall GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale. A FAFSA is required, as need will be given high priority.

**Requirements:** Applicants may choose to attend a 2-year, 4-year or accredited trade school. In addition to financial need, commitment to the community, participation in high school activities and excellence of character are also considered. All selections will be made on an objective and non-discriminatory basis.

### **Deadline & Application:**

Application deadline is March 1, on or before 11:59 P.M.

**Award:** The amount of the award is \$4,000. The scholarship is non-renewing – available for one year only - and the recipient will be announced at the winner's school at their awards program in May.

**Selection Committee:** Applications will be reviewed and the winner selected by members of the Davenport Schools Foundation Scholarship Committee.

If awarded this scholarship a verification of enrollment (Student Information Form) must be submitted to the Davenport Schools Foundation office by **June 1**. Failure to submit the Student Information Form may forfeit an award. Award funds will be distributed to the institution of enrollment in August.
