### Scholarship History:

The funder of this scholarship is a graduate of Davenport High School and a member of the Class of 1951.

**Eligibility:** This scholarship will be awarded to a Central High School graduating senior women's varsity tennis player who plans to participate in varsity tennis programs at the collegiate level. In the event no tennis applicant meets the criteria, the second choice is a varsity basketball player; if no basketball applicant meets the criteria, the third choice is a varsity volleyball player. The anonymous donor of the scholarship is an advocate of women's athletics and was involved in tennis in both high school and later life.

**Requirements:** 3.0 GPA or 23 ACT. Have participated in tennis (basketball second with volleyball third) and plan to participate in the sport at the varsity (not intramurals) level in college. Provide two letters of recommendation; one from the coach who has knowledge of the applicant's educational and athletic preparation. The second letter is from the applicant's choosing.

### Deadline & Application:

Application deadline is March 1, on or before 11:59 P.M.

**Award:** This endowed scholarship will award up to \$1000 to the recipient, subject to investment returns, one per year. Funds will be paid directly to the college or university.

If awarded this scholarship a verification of enrollment (Student Information Form) must be submitted to the Davenport Schools Foundation office by **June 1**. Failure to submit the Student Information Form may forfeit an award. Award funds will be distributed to the institution of enrollment in August.
