Scholarship History:

This scholarship was established by the family of Jason Blair Roberts to honor his memory.

Eligibility: Applicants must be a minority graduate from Davenport Central High School by the last day of June. Recipients must be enrolled in an accredited two- or four-year college or university in the U.S. An Expected Family contribution (EFC) score determined by the FAFSA form must be provided with the application.

Requirements: Selection of recipients is based on financial need, a GPA of 2.5 or above and must show involvement in extracurricular activities. All selections will be made on an objective and non-discriminatory basis.

Deadline & Application:

Application deadline is March 1, on or before 11:59 P.M.

Award: This endowed scholarship will award up to two (2) \$1000 awards recipients, subject to investment returns, one per year.

Selection Committee: Applications will be reviewed, and the winner selected by members of the Davenport Schools Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee which includes educators and counselors from the district, as well as community members and 2 DSF board members.

If awarded this scholarship a verification of enrollment (Student Information Form) must be submitted to the Davenport Schools Foundation office by **June 1**. Failure to submit the Student Information Form may forfeit an award. Award funds will be distributed to the institution of enrollment in August.
