Typical 9th Grade Schedule

- 1 - English 9 or Honors English 9
- 2 - Math
- 3 - Geoscience
- 4 - World History & Geography
- 5 - Physical Education/Lifetime Health
- 6 - Adv Comm Skills/Income and Money Management
- 7 - World Language or Elective
- 8 - Elective

Credit Information

Each class per semester is 0.5 credits

ex: English 9 (semester 1) = 0.5 credit

English 9 (semester 2) = 0.5 credit

English 9 (full year) = 1.0 credit

- Student must pass the class with a D- or better to be awarded credit for class
- 4 year University/College look for **core class grades** to be C- or better

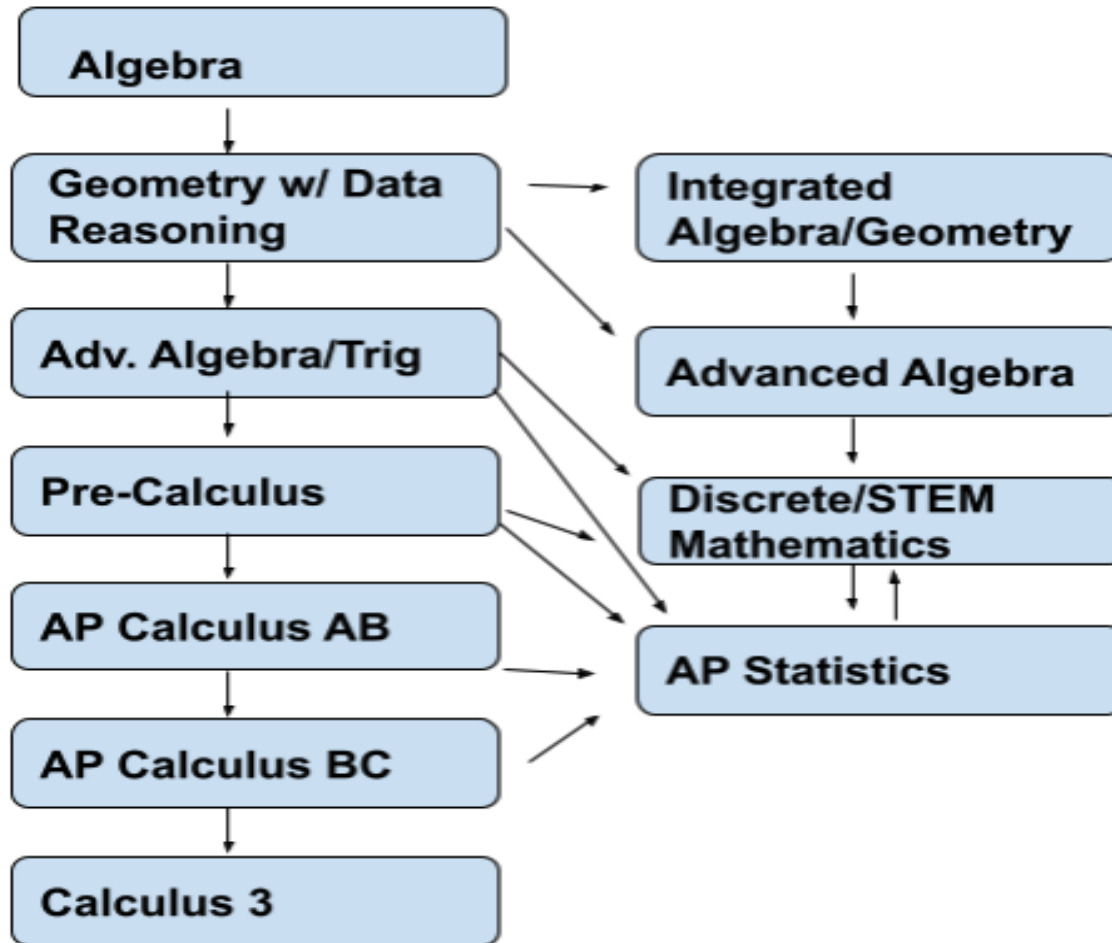
- English 9 or English 9 H - What is the difference?

MATHEMATICS

Graduation Requirements

- Students will still need to take at least three math courses at Lakeridge.
- Algebra and Geometry from LMS count as elective credit on the high school transcript.
- Most colleges require a minimum of Adv Algebra

MATHEMATIC OPTIONS/PATHS



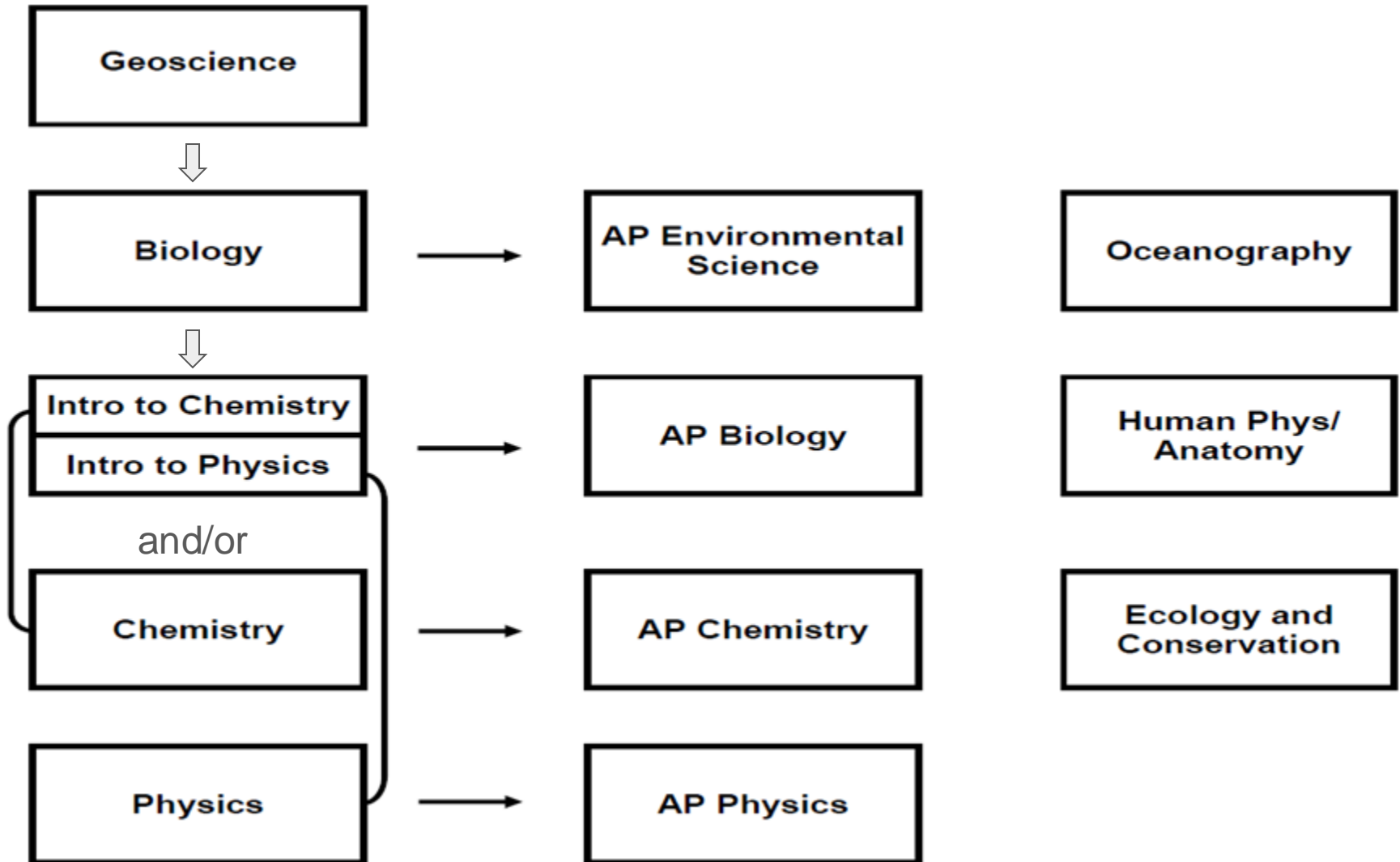
Science

Graduation Requirements

- 1 credit Earth & Space: Geoscience
- 1 credit Life Science: Biology
- 0.5 credits Physics and 0.5 credits of Chemistry

- All 9th graders will be enrolled into Geoscience
- To get ahead in Science, 9th graders can enroll into **both** Geoscience and Biology.

Science Options



SOCIAL STUDIES

- 3 credits to graduate
- All 9th graders will enroll into World History & Geography (1.0 credit)



World History/Geography (9th)



US History (1 Sem) (10th)



America & Contemporary World or AP US History (11th)



Civics (1 Sem) (11th or 12th)

World Language Placements

Spanish(1-4 & AP), French(1-4 & AP), Chinese(1-4 & AP) ASL (1-3)

- There is no prerequisite for level 1 of any language.
- We recommend that students have C's or above in core classes before starting a World Language.
- Students who successfully completed Level 1 or 2 of French or Spanish in 8th grade should enroll in the next level.
(Successful completion is defined as a B or better from middle school)
- Native speakers and students who are coming from language immersion programs in other schools or districts should contact their counselor regarding placement testing.

Health and PE

- 1 Health credit required for graduation
 - 0.5 credit **Lifetime Health** (9th/10th)
 - 0.5 credit Health Issues (11th/12th)
- 1 PE credit required for graduation
 - 0.5 credit **Physical Education** class (9th/10th)
 - 0.5 credit from any PE elective

Weight Training, Adv Training & Performance, Yoga, Team Sports, Aerobic
(Strength & Conditioning)

OR

- 0.5 credit from participating in any JV or Varsity Sport
11th/12th grade year

Credits from Lakeridge/Lake Oswego Middle School

- Algebra and Geometry from LMS count as elective credit on the high school transcript. Students will still need to take at least three math courses at Lakeridge.
- French and Spanish at LMS count as World Language credit on the high school transcript. Students need two years of World Language to graduate.
- Grades for classes completed before starting the 9th grade do not count in the high school GPA.
