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### Level 1: Teacher steps when a student breaks ANY Minor Rule

- 1 Verbal Warning/redirection
- 2 Student conference (remove audience) and/or <u>Paws</u> phone call
- 3 Assign a teacher consequence-Make parent contact
  - a. Write a minor incident referral
- 4 Office referral.
  - a. If the behavior continues in the same class, call for Tier 2 (persistent minor behavior)
  - b. 3 minors during the month for the same behavior (Ex. Disruption, Language)

#### Level 2 & 3: Teacher & Admin Steps when a student breaks ANY Major Rule

- 1 Teacher calls the main office for Tier 2 assistance and student is escorted to ISS by staff member a. Teacher writes office referral
- 2 Teacher writes office referral and Admin determines consequence

#### **Teacher Actions**

- Follow and document all steps of the consequence continuum
- Parent contact at step 3 of consequences
- Complete minor referral in Educator's Handbook
- After 3 minor infractions of the same behaviors become a major infraction and an office referral must be written. There should be documentation of minor incidents, as well as parent contact.

#### **Administrator Actions**

- Hold teachers accountable for following the consequence continuum and behavior matrix
- Make parent contact with major behavior infractions
- Look for documentation of 3 minor incidents and parent contact when receiving an office referral for a minor behavior
- Have individual conversations with teachers who write office referrals for minor incidents without documentation of 3 minor and evidence of following consequence continuum
- Follow NHCS Student Code of Conduct for major behavior incidents

#### Cell Phone/Earbud/Smartwatch/iPad Policy

**WMS Policy:** Cell Phones, smart watches, ipads, and personal earbud use is not permitted at WIlliston Middle from 8:00 am-Dismissal. Students are required to keep their phone out of sight.

#### 1st, 2nd, 3rd Offense

- 1. Teacher takes the device, labels the phone, and puts in secure location until it can be taken to Ms. James. She will make parent contact.
- 2. Parent/guardian picks up the phone from the front office.

# 4th Offense and beyond

1. Student will be required to leave the device at home.

Students who refuse to surrender device to administration will be assigned ISS for the remainder of the day.

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
