Summit High School students continuously bring home awards in numerous state and national competitive events.



MECHATRONICS

Reimagining robotics!

As part of the Software and Systems development pathway, Mechatronics is ideal for students interested in gaining a fundamental understanding of the creation of robotic and automated systems. Mechatronics students do much than study robots – they build them, interact with them, explore their design and function and push them to their limits. Upon successful completion of this pathway, students will have the opportunity to receive a certification in robotic automation while learning how to use the same technology used by some of today's leading innovators, such as Tesla and Amazon.



ETHICAL HACKING

Hack away cyber threats!

In a data-driven world, qualified cyber security professionals are on an essential line of defense against cyberattacks. Students in the Cyber Security pathway will learn how to apply industry accepted and emerging practices to solve real-world security problems including data breaches, malware and cyber scams. This pathway's hands-on curriculum provides students with the skills necessary to make computer systems invincible to hackers while also preparing students for the CompTIA A+ 220-901 and 220-910 certification exams.



GAMES AND SIMULATION

Let the games begin!

The Games and Simulation pathway introduces the concepts, tools and techniques that are involved in video game development. Incorporating elements of design, artistry, production and engineering, this pathway offers a unique educational experience for students and serves as the launching pad for them to play significant roles in the game design field. With hands-on instruction, students will dive into every aspect of creating video games for a variety of different audiences.



CYBER FORENSICS

The answer lies in the evidence.

For every crime, there is a story. Who is the victim? Who is the suspect? What was the motive? Part of the Public Safety industry sector, the Cyber Forensics pathway begins with an introduction to scientific inquiry and the process of forensic investigation of electronic sources, including the world wide web. This inquiry will then be applied to the analysis of cybercrime scenes as students learn to analyze physical and checmical evidence, including: microscopy, chromatology, and the analysis of fingerprints, hair, fiber, glass, and documents. Students will ultimately learn how to use their analytical skills to create conclusions for crimes through the study of firearms, toxicology, entomology, anthropology, blood

(serology), and DNA analysis.



INTERNATIONAL BUSINESS

Invest in your future!

Students in the International Business pathway move beyond "business as usual,"developing a community of leaners whose knowledge and entrepreneurial spirit will transform the business of tomorrow. Students will learn the fundamentals of economics at the local and global level and will focus on real-world topics such as career planning, personal financial management and the fundamentals of building a successful business. Students will have an opportunity to start and operate a student-run business while focusing on international business concepts including e-commerce, international trade and import/export policies and procedures Business students compete in SkillsUSA and an online stock market competition
