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

ABOUT US

Give Something Back (Give Back) provides college scholarships, academic mentoring, and social guidance to students who have faced adversity. The public charity has already prepaid over 1500 college scholarships across the country—a contribution of over \$36 million. Newly launched in 2017, our program in California focuses on empowering foster youth, homeless youth and children of incarcerated parents through mentorship and a college education.

Students can apply for our program as early as the eighth grade, although we accept students throughout high school based on availability and eligibility.

Give Back scholars participate in programming and mentoring throughout high school to prepare them for college-level curriculum. If our scholars are accepted at one of the organization's partner colleges, Give Back is committed to providing tuition, fees, room, and board for four years. For some of our scholars, community college or technical training may be a better option after high school graduation. While the Give Back scholarship does not apply, scholars will continue to receive academic advising, career counseling and mentoring.
