





## GRADUATION RATE RISES TO HIGHEST IN DECADES

The MVCSD's 2023-2024 graduation rate climbed to a level not seen in more than two decades. The projected graduation rate - 79.9% increased 5.6 percentage points over the previous year.



## MVCSD PASSES 2024-2025 BUDGET TO DELIVER HIGH QUALITY PROGRAMS TO STUDENTS

Voters approved a \$271,266,317 budget for the MVCSD 2024-2025 school year. The budget increases spending by \$5,296,496, or 1.99%, from the previous year. The spending plan maintains academic and extracurricular programming and expands and continues investments in academic initiatives, including early childhood education and technology and dual language programs.



## NEW OPERATIONS & ACCOUNTABILITY DEPARTMENT PROJECTS IMPROVE BUILDINGS AND PERFORMANCE

The MVCSD Operations and Accountability Department successfully completed several projects to directly improve the safety and educational experience throughout the District.

- ▶ Removal and abandonment of all oil tanks in compliance with NYSED and Westchester County DOH requirements.
- Merger of Rebecca Turner Elementary School and Benjamin Turner Middle School. Provided all logistical, operational and public relations support for the entire undertaking.



## OPERATIONS & ACCOUNTABILITY

- All buildings were inspected and received certificates of occupancy, a massive undertaking for a school district with 17 buildings.
- ▶ Comprehensive security camera upgrade for five schools BTA, MVLA, MVHA, Hamilton School and Grimes School at a significant cost savings from the previously contracted camera company and utilized remaining grant money resulting in zero cost to the District.
- ▶ Purchased four government-level X-Ray machines directly from the manufacturer for three high schools, providing security improvements.

## OPERATIONS & ACCOUNTABILITY

- ▶ Successful District-wide emergency abatement of asbestos was also completed weeks before the opening of schools in 15 classrooms at MVHS, the Pupil Personnel Services suite and bathroom at the Board of Education and a bathroom at Edward Williams School, improving the safety of all individuals in those buildings.
- Led a partnership with City Hall, Westchester Youth Shelter, the Mount Vernon Youth Bureau to create a cannabis court and find alternative disciplinary pathways to implement restorative practices for challenged youth, while offering them additional and nontraditional pathways to success.
- Negotiated costs for an affordable transportation contract to provide reliable transport to students.


## OPERATIONS & ACCOUNTABILITY

Renovation work was completed in 24 rooms at Graham School to make the building safe for students and staff. The Buildings and Grounds Department completed the work quickly after a collapse in August, so Graham students could go back to school as soon as possible. The school reopened September 16, 2024.



## GRAHAM SCHOOL SUCCESSFULLY REOPENS INPERSON AFTER ONLINE START

Students started in-person learning at Graham School on September 16, 2024, after renovations. Students were learning remotely for the first two weeks of school. Graham School administrators, teachers and teaching assistants worked to build relationships with students and their families to make the remote start successful. Some Graham students were also transferred to provide minimal disruption to their inperson learning.



# DISTRICT DRAMATICALLY IMPROVES DATA COLLECTION AND ACCURACY

The District recorded significant improvements in its state data reporting by receiving a score of 87% accuracy. Accurate and consistent data ensures compliance with state reporting requirements, which can affect funding and resources allocated to schools. It also ensures that the District can implement proper individualized learning plans for students.



## BUILDING REORGANIZATION SURVEYS

Three surveys have been released to assess the community's support for reorganizing the District's K-8 buildings. The proposed reconfiguration involves shifting grades seven and eight to separate areas of the three themed high schools.



#### CTE AUTOMOTIVE PARTNERSHIP WITH FORD EXPANDS

MVCSD partners with Ford and Rockland Community College for the Ford Automotive Career Exploration (ACE) program. The expansion of the program, which began in 2022, was announced on Thursday, November 16, 2023.





## RALLY AGAINST STATE EDUCATION CUTS HELD AT BENJAMIN TURNER ACADEMY

Over 50 community members, students, educators and local representatives lined up on the steps outside BTA to protest state education cuts on Friday, March 1, 2024. After over a month of lobbying with state and local officials, the District prevailed and will receive the \$2.9 million that was set to be removed from the budget.
