# **COUNSELOR'S CORNER:**

#### PSAT Scores (8th Grade)

We are excited to inform you that the College Board has released the PSAT 8/9 scores. The 8th grade students that took the PSAT 8/9 here at school on October 9th can now access their score at <u>www.collegeboard.org</u>. No printed score reports will be issued from the College Board.

If your student has not already signed up for a College Board account, he/she will need to create a new account. Please go to <u>www.collegeboard.org</u> and click the "Create Account" button. Students will click "Student" and then enter their student information, parent information, and username/password. Students will need to verify their email address and phone number. Once they have created their account, their PSAT 8/9 test scores can be found.

If your student's test score is not posted in their College Board account and he/she needs an access code, please have your student come to Mrs. Pizzitola's office. If the information your student entered on their PSAT matches with the information used to create their College Board account, your student will not need this code.

Join us for this wonderful opportunity to explore new books and encourage a love of reading! We can't wait to see you there!




#### James and the Giant Peach Jr.

#### **External Emails**

School starts at 7:45 a.m. and ends at 3:05 p.m.

# Middle School Drop-Off

Students may be dropped off beginning at 7:15 a.m. (If you need to drop your child off earlier, please sign them up for the Extended Care Program.) Students arriving after 7:15 a.m. will go directly to the cafeteria and will be dismissed at 7:30 a.m. to go to their lockers and then to their first period class. All students should be dropped off in the front car line area. There will be staff outside directing traffic and welcoming students. Students are not allowed to go upstairs until 7:30 A. M.

# Middle School Afternoon Pick-Up (Middle School Students only)

Students should report immediately after the 3:05 p.m. dismissal to the front of the school. Pick up will be made in one of two lines. Students with the last name beginning with the alphabet

A-M is picked up in the lane closest to the school.

N - Z is picked up outside lane between the 1st and 2nd row of parked cars

There is staff outside assisting students to their cars. Please make sure you have your car tag visible.

#### Middle School Afternoon Pick Up (Upper, Middle and Lower School Students)

Students of carpools that also include upper school and/or lower school students report to the area outside the front doors and wait for the lower school carpool to begin at 3:15 p.m.

Upper school carpool begins at 3:30 p.m.

Any student not picked up by 3:45 p.m. goes to the Extended Care Program and regular extended care fees are billed to the parent's account.

No middle school student is allowed to leave campus from the upper school.

### Lunch

"A" lunch for 5th and 6th grade students is from 12:10 p.m. to 12:45 p.m. on regular days and 12:00 p.m. - 12:35 p.m. on Chapel days.

"B" lunch for 7th and 8th grade students is from 1:00 p.m. - 1:35 p.m. on regular days and 12:50 p.m. - 1:25 p.m. on Chapel days.

You are always welcome to come and join your child for lunch.

We do not allow DoorDash deliveries for students.

# Technology

All Middle School students are issued an iPad for their school use. Students may use their own device at home; however while on campus, they will be required to use the school issued IPAD only.

5th grade students do not take IPADS home.

6th, 7th and 8th grade students are responsible for bringing their IPADS to and from home, as well as making sure they are fully charged each day.

The office will no longer issue students a loaner IPAD in the event they leave theirs at <u>home.</u>

# **MYFBCA and Student Password**

MyFBCA is our online portal where parents and students can see classes and resources. Please follow the instructions below to obtain your student's password information.

- 1. Sign in to MyFBCA as a parent with your email address
- 2. Under Children select the student's name
- 3. Click on the Contact Card tab
- 4. Under General Information note the Student ID #

Student ID numbers are only visible to faculty, staff, the student, and the student's parent/guardian. A student ID # should never be shared with anyone else. The default password for students will be Fb+Student ID # (for example, the student has a student ID # of 12502099, therefore the temporary password is Fb12502099).
