Additionally, we have a Parent Link tab on our webpage to assist you with resources to help support you as a parent. All our teachers use Remind in order to keep an open line of communication. We encourage all families to read with their children at least 20 minutes a day.

Q - What are the dates of scheduled parent-teacher conferences?

A – We have November 8, 2023 and November 9, 2023 scheduled for parent-teacher conferences. Additionally parents can access the Events Calendar on the CCMES website. Parents can always request a conference at any point in the school year.

Q - How will I receive reports of my child’s progress? What tool(s) are available so that I can regularly check on my child’s attendance and academic progress?

A – Parents/guardians will receive reports of their child’s progress by mail and they can check Empower. Empower is new this year. This was new platform for reporting progress was reviewed at parent teacher conference. A letter with parent login information was also sent home or shared by the teacher.
