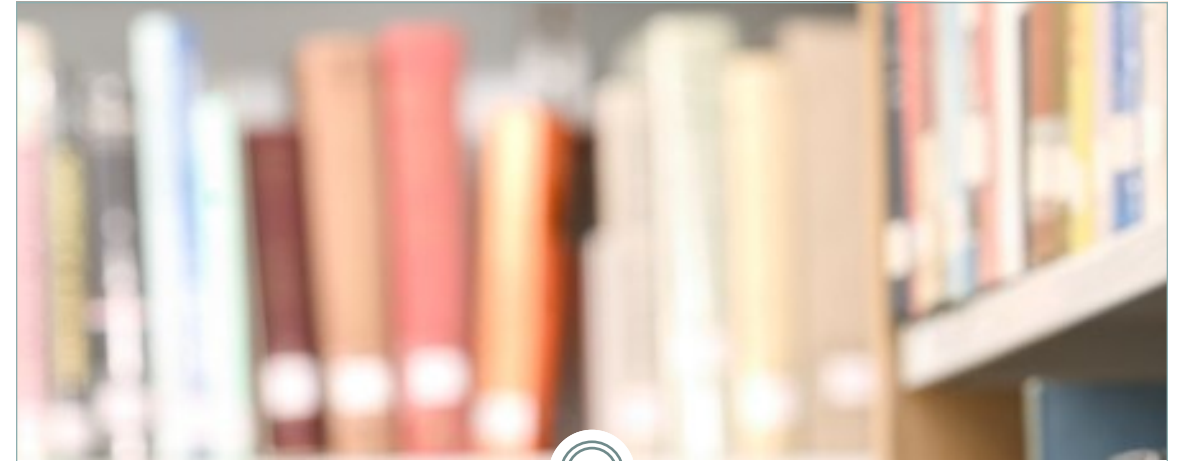

Our Veteran's Day field trip to the assembly at North Campus is on Monday, November 11th. Central 4th graders will be performing the Preamble to the US Constitution.

Veteran's Day is a patriotic celebration and a day that is valued at TCA. TCA will pay tribute to all the men and women who have bravely served our great nation as a member of the US Armed Forces on Monday, November 11th from 9:30am-10:45am in the North Campus gym. We invite you to come celebrate this day with us.

This year's keynote speaker for TCA's 2024 Veteran's Day assembly will be Mr. Lavon Coles.
