Our school utilizes the SchoolMessenger system to deliver text messages, straight to your mobile phone with important information about events, school closings, safety alerts and more.*

You can participate in this free service* just by sending a text message of "Y" or "Yes" to our school's short code number, 67587.

You can also opt out of these messages at any time by simply replying to one of our messages with "Stop".

SchoolMessenger is compliant with the <u>Student Privacy</u> <u>PledgeTM</u> so you can rest assured that your information is safe and will never be given or sold to anyone.

Information on SMS text messaging and Short Codes: SMS stands for Short Message Service and is commonly referred to as a "text message". Most cell phones support this type of text messaging. Our notification provider, SchoolMessenger, uses a true SMS protocol developed by the telecommunications industry specifically for mass text messaging, referred to as "short code" texting. This method is fast, secure and highly reliable because it is strictly regulated by the wireless carriers and only allows access to approved providers.

If you've ever sent a text vote for a TV show to a number like 46999, you have used short code texting.

Information on SMS text messaging and Short Codes: SMS significa "servicio de mensajes cortos" y comúnmente se conoce como un "mensaje de texto". La mayoría de los teléfonos celulares son compatibles con este tipo de mensajes de texto. Nuestro proveedor de notificación, SchoolMessenger, utiliza un cierto protocol SMS desarrollado por la industria de las telecomunicaciones específicamente para enviar mensajes de texto en masa, referido como mensajes de texto "código corto." Este método es rápido, seguro y muy confiable, y está estrictamente regulado por los proveedores de servicios inalámbricos y sólo permite el acceso a los proveedores aprobados. Si alguna vez ha enviado un voto de texto para un programa de televisión a un número como 46999, usted ha usado los mensajes de texto de código corto.

Spring 2025 Applications Due by 12/2!

I hope your semester has been going well. Ours has been full here. Last week, we celebrated National Transfer Student Week. As part of the week-long festivities, we had our Grand Opening of UNM's Transfer & Transition Student Center. It serves not only our transfer and branch transition students, but also Dual Credit students! For your students attending courses on campus, they are welcome to visit our center, have some refreshments or hang out and study. They will need to have their UNM student ID# (or LoboCard) handy to check in. REMINDER - the Spring 2025 dual credit application are due IN FULL on Monday, December 2nd. We will not be accepting applications after that date.

Students should do BOTH the UNM Dual Credit application and the Major/Career Interest form at the same time (not required for students taking dual credit at high school). When I get the MCI form, I email the student (cc to counselor and the advising unit) directions on who with and how to make the advising appointment. The webpage for application link, MCI form link, NM Dual Credit Request form, and other important info and deadlines are found at https://advisement.unm.edu/dual-credit/admissions-process.html As a reminder, students must meet eligibility requirements to apply.

ALSO –official high school transcripts must be provided to dualcredit@unm.edu (returning UNM students from fall 2024 do not need to submit high school or college transcripts) NOTE: If new students have done college courses elsewhere than UNM, those official transcripts MUST be submitted to admissions at the same time as doing the dual credit application. Those transcripts can be sent directly to apply@unm.edu

The Schedule of Classes is available now at https://schedule.unm.edu/ With information on course options discussed with their academic advisor, the student and you can complete the NM DCR form at that time (see link in above paragraph). The timeline on page 2 is helpful.
