Students in this class will learn and practice strategies for taking the ACT test. The class will examine the sections of the test and will discuss the strategies and timing needed for each section. Students will need a Chromebook, pencil, and a calculator.

Students should plan to attend all seven dates in the session. There will be a test simulation on the second-to-last day, so students will be in class for about 3.5 hours that day. Please note, this class is primarily for 11th grade students (Juniors). Seating is limited to the first 50 students.
