### 1. Committee Reports & Updates

A. Principal report:

Mr. Gilligan shared data from iready showing comparison from other schools in the same district with similar student population, size. Big Lake 56% Butte Elementary 48% Dena'ina 54% Finger Lake 6% Macheztanz 61%. Students are currently taking STAR: Math Testing from current data school is making growth and is on target.

*Pre-enrollment: 189 student population. Middle school and high school numbers are growing and expected to spike.* 

Sports application to ASAA has been submitted. There is a huge interest to attend mainly because basketball it will happen, but in the works. Elite the sports program there is no credit through ELITE miscommunication this is also confusing parents. There was conversation on who is in authority to give information about what KCS will offer and this again confusing parents.
