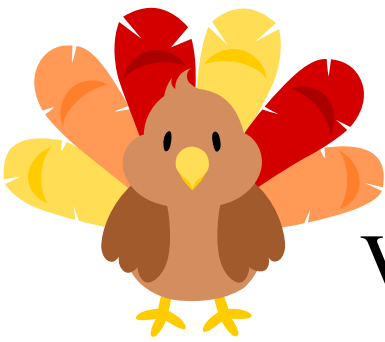
We finished the week by making scarecrows and writing scarecrow stories. The kids have a fantastic imagination!

I hope everyone has a restful weekend!

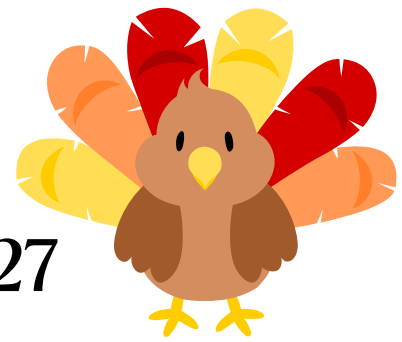
