

Policy IJK Supplementary Materials Selection and Adoption - DRAFT

Issued 9/05, 9/24

Purpose: To establish the board's vision for the selection and adoption of supplementary materials.

1 Supplementary materials are any instructional materials other than textbooks including, but not limited to, the following.

- books
- periodicals
- newspapers
- press cuttings
- pictures
- diagrams
- maps
- charts
- photocopies
- slides
- 2 · filmstrips
- films
- records
- audiotapes
- videotapes
- computer programs / software
- CD Roms
- electronic materials

3 The superintendent may not permit supplementary materials to be used unless directly related to instruction and reflected in instructional plans.

4 It is the policy of the board to provide supplemental educational materials that support and enrich the curriculum and enhance the district's educational program. The board believes that the availability of carefully selected and widely varied collection of supplementary materials enhances students' learning.

5 The superintendent or his/her designee must review and approve supplementary materials in accordance with the standards outlined in state board regulation and policy IJ and IJJ.
