

What is an Ambassador for Christ?

An Ambassador for Christ is an organization of Sophomore, Junior, and Senior Mater Dei Catholic students who accept Jesus Christ as a role model and share in the mission of being the face and hands of Christ to others. As representatives of Christ, Ambassadors strive to bring Christ to others in many ways.

So, we are Ambassadors for Christ, God making his appeal through us. We beseech you on behalf of Christ, be reconciled to God. For our sake he made him to be sin who knew no sin, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.

What are some specific duties the Ambassadors have?

Acting as the face of Christ and of the school, Ambassadors are involved in many school functions where student help is needed. Their responsibilities include Community Service, Public Relations, Marketing, Welcoming Committee, International Events, 8th Grade Visitations, Shadowing and Touring of the Campus all while developing and perfecting their public speaking abilities.

Qualifications to become an Ambassador for Christ

- Any current Freshman, Sophomore, or Junior who models Christ and Christian values.
- Excels in public relations, public speaking, and time management.
- Have and maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA.

Requirements of an Ambassador for Christ

- All Ambassadors are required to assist with the High School Open House, 8th Grade Visitation, and Blue and Gold Night.
- Upcoming Sophomore, and Junior Ambassadors for Christ are required to have volunteered for two events by Christmas break.
- Upcoming Senior Ambassadors for Christ are required to have volunteered for three events by Christmas break.
- Ambassadors for Christ are required to volunteer a <u>minimum of three events</u> throughout the school year. Serving more than the minimum is welcomed, encouraged, and greatly appreciated.

Leggings or tights with mesh, advertising, brand names, etc. are not permitted. No sweatpants under skirts. Black Flat Dress Shoes. Athletic shoes, platform shoes and high heels are not permitted.

Probation Policy

- If you do not attend the High School Open House, 8th Grade Visitation, or Blue and Gold Night, you will be removed from the Ambassadors for Christ Corps.
- If suspended from school, placed on disciplinary probation, or become academically ineligible you may not be eligible to apply or forfeit your leadership position as an Ambassador for Christ.
- Academic Eligibility from the Student Handbook



Participation in extra-curricular activities is a privilege. Eligible students may participate in extracurricular activities to include but not limited to: hold office or campaign for office in student leadership programs, school clubs, plays, attend dances, or participate in athletics. Students will be deemed ineligible during any nine-week grading period in which ANY of the following criteria are met:

- Weighted GPA for the grading period is below 2.0
- Student earns 2 "U's" for Citizenship. Citizenship is an indication of a student's general classroom behavior including participation, AM and Class tardies, etc. Excessive tardies may result in a U grade in citizenship. Ineligibility includes all extra-curricular activities including participation in athletics and clubs, attending school-sponsored events such as dances, or any other activity outside of the normal school day.
- o Student earns 2 "F" grades.
- Students who are deemed ineligible at the quarter and/or have either D's or F's on their progress report or Transcript may be assigned Mandatory After School tutoring. Failure to attend may result in academic dismissal from Mater Dei.
- If become academically ineligible, student will no longer be pulled from class for school day meetings and events.
- Ineligible students will be assigned a grade-check log to complete each week of coursework to improve their grades and become academically eligible. This log must be submitted at the end of each week to Mr. Hart
- Student will have until the next 5-week grade check to become academically eligible, or the student will be removed from the Ambassador for Christ Corps.
- Depends on the severity and is handled on a case-by-case basis.
- The maximum consequence could be removal from the Ambassador for Christ Corps.
