

# 1ST GRADE PLACEMENT TESTING

The purpose of placement testing at Veritas Academy is to ensure that applicants have the appropriate skills for the grade level they will be entering in the upcoming school year. Grammar School testing focuses on the areas of grammar, reading, writing, and mathematics and is a one-one-one assessment with one of our classroom teachers. The results of the assessment will be reviewed by the Veritas admissions committee, along with your child's complete application, to determine placement and/or admission. In some cases, an academic meeting may be scheduled to review testing results.

## OBJECTIVES

The below objectives are skills that are assessed for applicants going into the 1st Grade. While we will take into account the timing of the assessment and understand that these skills may/may not have been covered in your child's current curriculum, a conceptual understanding in the listed areas is needed for successful placement in the 1st Grade.

### MATH

- Identify basic shapes
- Count by 1s to 100, 10s to 100
- 1 to 1 number/object correspondence
- Identify coins
- Sorting
- Identifying most/fewest
- Measuring with nonstandard units
- Addition math facts

### LANGUAGE ARTS

- Reading fluency of 60-80 words per minute in grade level reader
- Reading Comprehension
- Neat, well formed print
- Knowledge of basic concepts of print and grammar (capitals, lowercase letters, spacing, punctuation)

- Addition and Subtraction math facts

- Reading fluency of 80-100 words per minute in grade level reader
- Reading Comprehension
- Neat, well formed print
- Knowledge of basic concepts of print and grammar (capitals, lowercase letters, spacing, punctuation)

# 3RD GRADE PLACEMENT TESTING

- Adding sums
- Finding the missing addend
- Ordinal numbers
- Addition and Subtraction math facts

### LANGUAGE ARTS

- Reading fluency of 100-120 words per minute in grade level reader
- Reading Comprehension
- Identifying the central theme of a composition
- Neat, well formed print; beginning knowledge of cursive writing
- Knowledge of basic concepts of print and grammar (capitals, lowercase letters, spacing, punctuation)

- Math facts (all operations)

- Reading fluency of 120-140 words per minute in grade level reader
- Reading Comprehension
- Identifying the central theme of a composition
- Neat, well formed cursive handwriting
- Knowledge of basic concepts of print and grammar (capitals, lowercase letters, spacing, punctuation)
