

## State Fair Art Exhibit Guidelines

ESD 105 has developed these guidelines to ensure that we create a community-wide student art exhibit for the Fair. Each year teachers from across the valley work together to set up and hang the student art exhibit.

## **Guidelines:**

- All K-12 classrooms are encouraged to take this opportunity to display samples of their student art.
- NO LIMIT: Classrooms may enter as many as they like.
- ONE teacher from each building is asked to bring the art to the fairgrounds on the scheduled date to hang the art.
- Art must be matted. No frames. Art may be glued to construction paper.
- Art must be labeled with the correct label. (templet on art webpage)
- Art must have the correct district symbol (symbol list is on art webpage)
- Teacher registration form must be presented at the time of exhibit set up.

Teachers are asked to review all art entries to ensure that the art meets the requirements for display to the public.

ESD105 reserves the right to remove art from the display that is deemed inappropriate. No gang content, gang colors, gang symbols, or inappropriate for young children. The artwork will be removed without prior notification.
