Application Directions

- The <u>Student Application</u> must be legibly completed in black or blue ink. Be sure that no questions (1-7) are incomplete. Signatures are required for item #12 on the actual application.
- Student applicant must complete the Student Questionnaire.
- Carefully review the writing prompt. Responses can be typed. Carefully follow the directions for the <u>Student</u> <u>Writing Sample</u>. This must be completed by the student.
- Included in the application packet is the <u>Parent/Student Contract</u>. This form must be signed, dated, and returned with the application.
- For the School Counselor: The School Counselor Checklist and six (6) Student Recommendation Forms. The forms must be completed by the student's **CURRENT 8**th **grade** English teacher, math teacher, science teacher, social studies teacher, principal, and school counselor. <u>Applicants</u>: Please write the student's name on all the forms (the checklist and the recommendation forms) and give the forms to the School Counselor. The counselor may request that the student distribute the recommendation forms to their current teachers.

The school counselor will collect the Student Recommendation Forms and must include the following items: student transcript, current report card, test scores, discipline record, and attendance record; with the recommendation forms when returning the school packet to Akron Early College High School.

The school counselor will return all information from the school to AECHS by: Monday, December 2.
