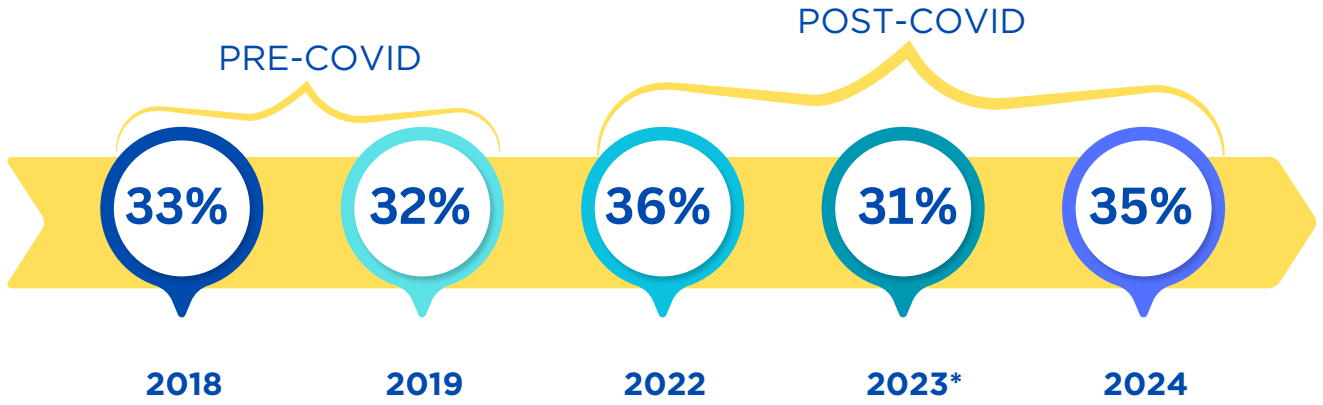

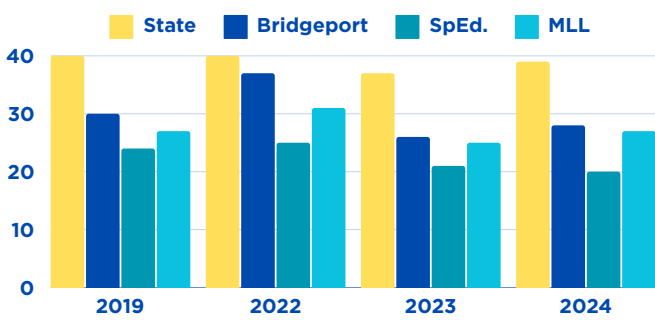
MATHEMATICS STUDENT GROWTH RATE

Percent of students meeting their growth targets on the Mathematics state assessment.



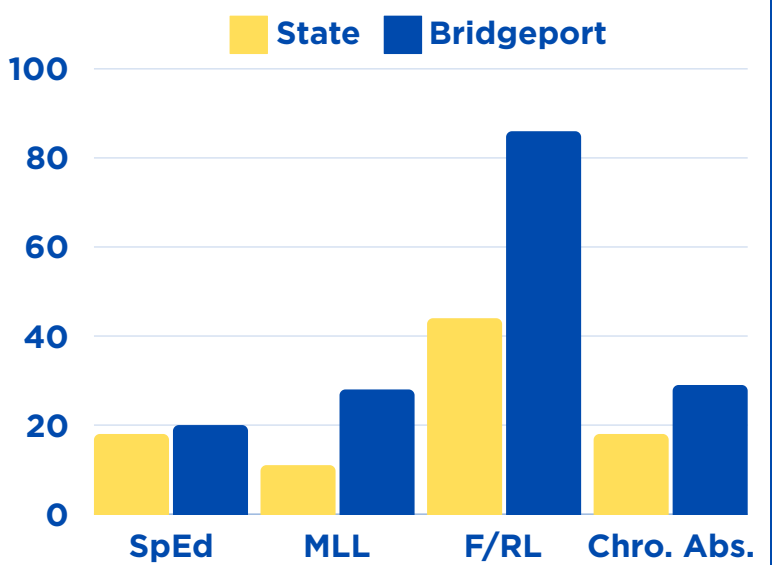

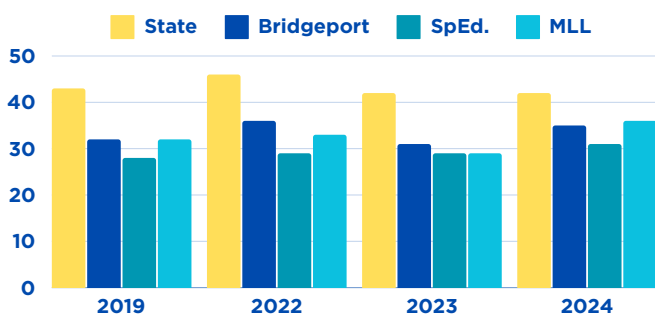
Comparison across groups for percent of students meeting growth expectations on ELA state assessment.

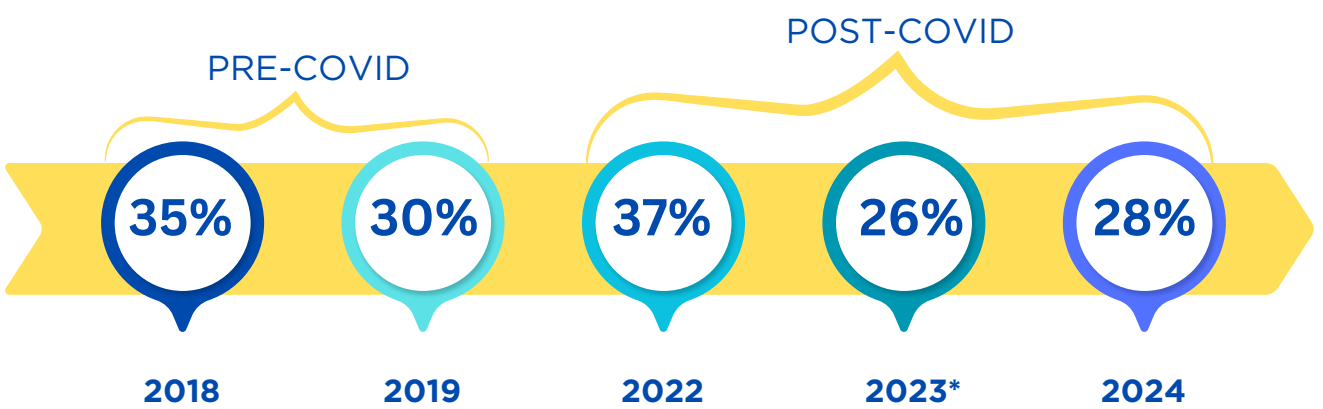
MATHEMATICS COMPARISON

ELA STUDENT GROWTH

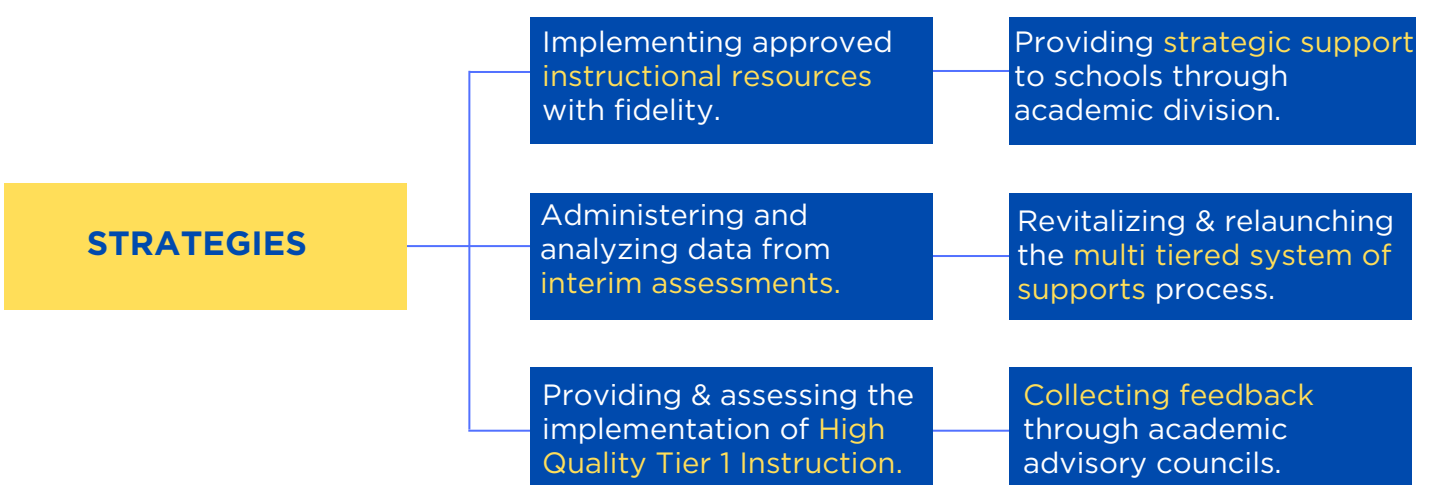
Percent of students their growth targets on the English Language Arts state assessment.

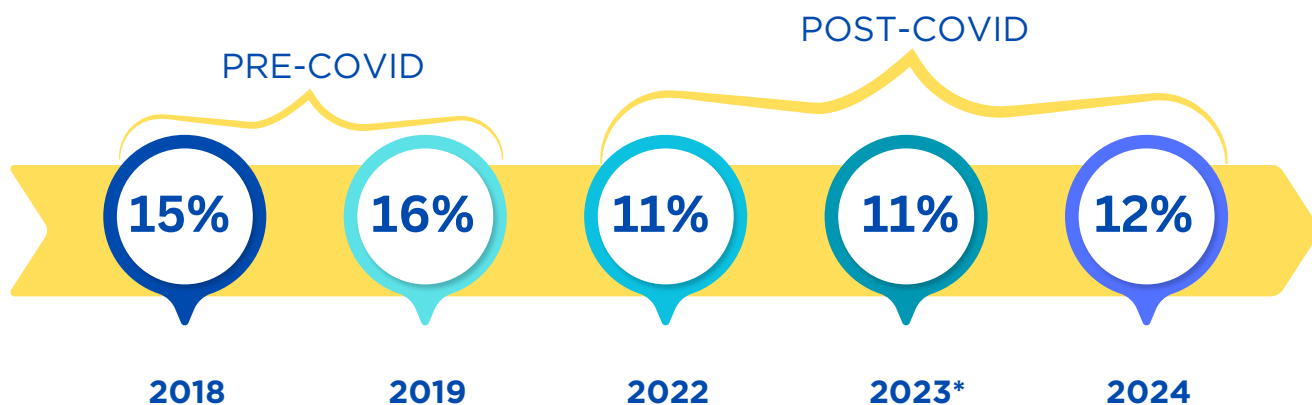

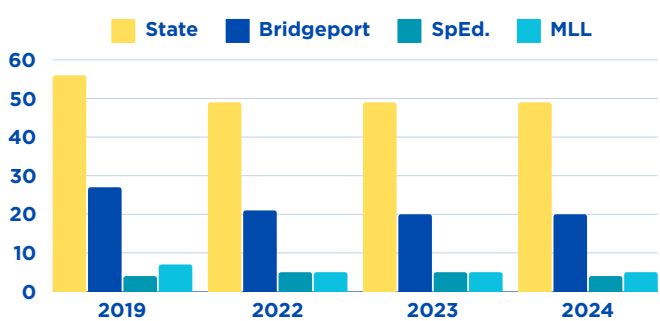
MATHEMATICS STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT

Percent of students meeting or exceeding expectations on the Mathematics state assessment.



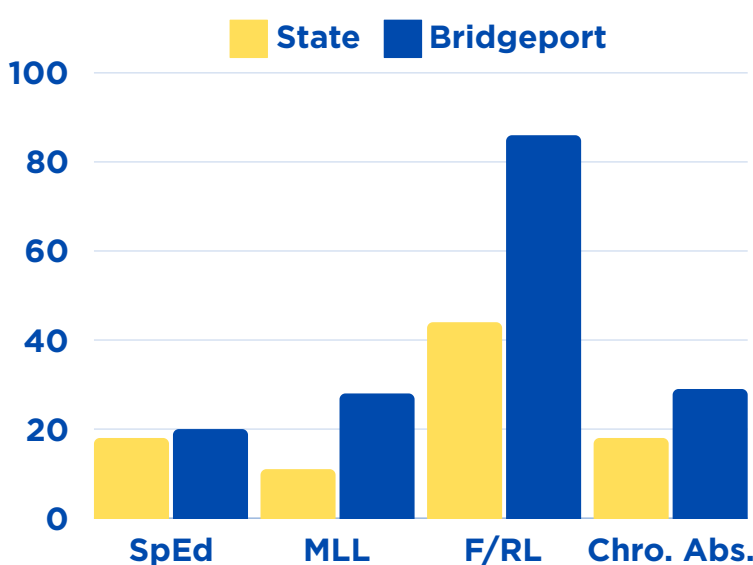

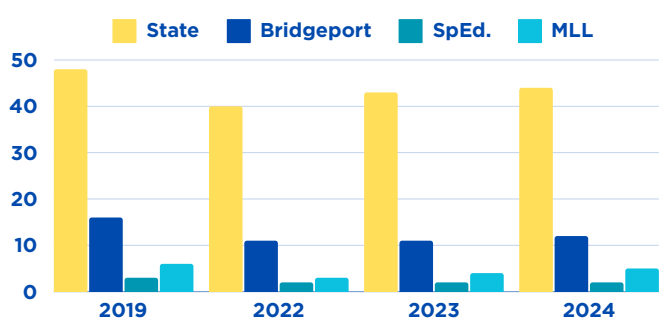
Comparison across groups for percent of students meeting or exceeding expectations on ELA state assessment.

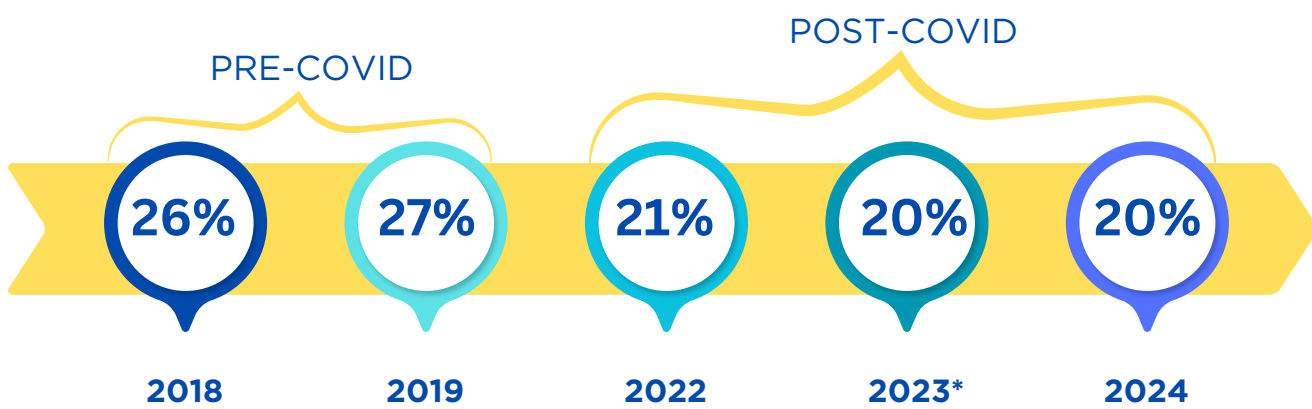
MATHEMATICS COMPARISON
