ACADEMICS

Justin Emrich, Buckeye Valley High School Class of 1999, proudly claims the titles of husband, father, educator, and graduate, with both a Bachelor and Master's degree from The Ohio State University. Justin spends his days teaching 8th-grade social studies at Olentangy Berkshire Middle School but also dedicates time as a Master Teacher for the Gilder Lehrman Institute of American History and as a faculty member at Otterbein University. A highly honored professional and recognized leader, workshop presenter, published author, and Teacher of the Year, Justin is known and respected for his passion, dedication, and commitment to education.

Russell Ty Herriott, Buckeye Valley Class of 2001, a multiple sport letter winner while at BV, Ty's athletic abilities shined on the baseball field. Considered, by many, to be the greatest baseball player in Buckeye Valley High School history, Ty is the holder of numerous hitting records at Buckeye Valley and is ranked in the Top 10 in the history of the State of Ohio in Hits, Batting Average,

BVLS BOND LEVY FACT SHEET

Home Runs and RBI's. He also holds the Highest all-time single season (.627) batting average in Ohio High School history. As a scholarship baseball player for Oakland University, he was a 4-year letterman where he completed his career as the school record holder in games started and played, at-bats, home runs, RBI's, and total bases. Following his time at Oakland University Ty had a stint playing professional baseball.

Zach Kreft, Buckeye Valley Class of 2018, is easily considered to be the greatest distance runner in Buckeye Valley High School history. A two-time State Champion in Cross Country, Zach was also the Indoor and Outdoor State Track and Field Champion as well as a multiple-time placer, both indoors and outdoors, at the state meets. During Zach's high school career, he dominated the MOAC in both cross country and track and field. In addition to holding numerous school records, Zach was named a High School All-American. Following graduation, Zach was a scholar-athlete and letterman in cross country and indoor and outdoor track at the University of Notre Dame (undergraduate) and Walsh University (graduate) and was named a Collegiate All-American. Zach is currently running professionally for the Columbus Track Club.

Michael P. Marshall holds the title as the longest-tenured and winningest head football coach in Buckeye Valley High School history. Mike has spent 47 years coaching interscholastic football, with 28 years as a head coach and 21 of those years at BV - 10 years as Varsity Head Football Coach (58-42), three years as a Varsity Assistant Football Coach, and 8 years coaching at Buckeye Valley Middle School where he garnered a 70-35-3 record. In 2008, Mike led the Barons to the MOAC Championship Title. Mike is a 1978 graduate of Miami University and 1984 graduate of the University of Dayton where he received his Masters degree.

Tricia Wilkinson Shaw, Buckeye Valley Class of 1975, is deemed a pioneer of girls' sports at Buckeye Valley. While at Buckeye Valley, girls' athletics transitioned from club status to interscholastic. A letter winner in volleyball, basketball, and track and field, Tricia was the first Buckeye Valley girl selected to the Mid-Ohio Girls Volleyball team. In 1974 Tricia capped off her final volleyball season by being honored as a member of the All State Volleyball team. Following graduation, Tricia continued competing in both volleyball and softball at the College of Wooster.

This new class of BV Hall of Fame members will be recognized at the Varsity Boys Basketball game against Bishop Ready on January 25, 2025.

Shop With A Cop Deadline Is November 4th

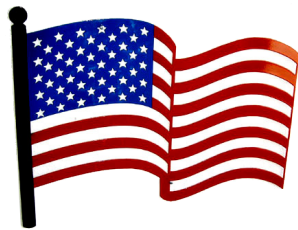
The Delaware County Sheriff's Office Shop with a Cop application deadline is November 4th.
