Big Beaver Falls Area School District Tax Information-NO PER CAPITA

The Big Beaver Falls Area School District School Board is pleased to announce that the District per-capita tax will not be collected beginning July 1, 2024. The City per-capita tax is separate from the School District tax and may/will still be collected. The Board recognizes in these trying times, any relief would be welcomed. Again, the 2024-2025 District per capita will not be collected.

Big Beaver Falls Area School District Tax Information-School District Real Estate Taxes

City of Beaver Falls – All School District Real Estate Taxes are to be collected by Berkheimer, Inc. The City of Beaver Falls will not collect any School Real Estate Taxes for the 2024-2025 School Year. Big Beaver, Eastvale, Homewood, Koppel, New Galilee and White Township- All School Real Estate Taxes will be collected by the local tax collector as in the past. Please contact your local tax office with questions.

Tax Rate: 11.66

Tax Billable Rate: 11.50

Homestead/Farmstead tax relief: \$581.83

Each eligible Homestead/Farmstead household will receive up to a \$581.83 reduction off their school taxes. Some individuals will not have a tax payment for the 2024-2025 school year. Last year's reduction was \$521.50, resulting in a \$60.33 increase for this year. Due to the County-wide Reassessment and to cover operational expenses, the District adjusted its millage rate to 11.66 for the 2024-25 tax year. As a result of increased funding from the state for the Homestead/Farmstead eligible properties, the District is opting to reduce its tax rate for from 11.66 to 11.5 to all tax payers. This reduction will help distribute all remaining Homestead/Farmstead dollars. The District apologizes for any confusion on this matter but are following Pennsylvania constitution and other applicable state laws.
