<p>Apply for CCP admission at the college of your choice. Use the college's website to apply. Use a personal email address, not your CHS email. Read their CCP webpages thoroughly and follow all application instructions.</p> <p>If you need your transcript sent to a college for admission, see CCP Coordinator, Mrs. Fleischman, or your Unit Counselor.</p> <p>Students must meet the college's admission requirements in order to participate in CCP at that college.</p> <p>Once admitted, the college will send you an email at the email address you used to apply. <p>Meet with an Advisor at the institution you're planning to take courses from to register for courses for the upcoming term (summer or fall). *Except for the Wright State English courses <u>AT CHS</u>.</p> <p>*If you plan to take a Wright State English course <u>at CHS</u> (we offer two courses: ENG 2040 - Literature, and ENG 1100 - First Year Composition), you don't need to meet with a WSU advisor. Instead, request the course(s) on HAC in the English section during CHS scheduling window (February 2025). <u>You must have applied to Wright State and have been admitted by the May 1st deadline in order to take these courses!</u></p>	<input type="checkbox"/>	May 15, 2025

<p>Submit a copy of your registered course(s) to your Unit Counselor.</p> <p>Discuss the college courses that you will be taking with your Unit Counselor to see how that will impact your graduation requirements.</p> <p>If you need to make changes to next year's schedule based on your CCP courses, meet with your Unit Counselor to do so before the last day of school!</p>	<input type="checkbox"/>	Before the last day of school

NOTES

- *Credit hour limit within the CCP program is 30 per school year and 120 total of all school years in CCP, including high school credit. The formula to calculate credit hours is: add up high school credits for the school year and multiply by 3, then add the amount of credit hours each CCP course is worth.*
- *Only courses for which students pass and earn credit will be covered financially. Centerville City Schools will seek reimbursement from the student/family for course withdrawals after the college's 100% refund date or failed courses.*
- *Students must be taking 5 high school courses (or the equivalent) each semester. CCP courses worth 3 credit hours or more count as 2 credits for this calculation. If you're an athlete, double check OHSAA's eligibiltiy requirements or see our Athletic Director.*
- *Before dropping a CCP course, meet with your Unit Counselor to see how this might impact graduation requirements, athletic eligibility, full-time student status, or your CHS schedule.*
