Community Support: Verona Area School District residents passed an operating referendum in the fall of 2022 by the greatest margin of support in Dane County.

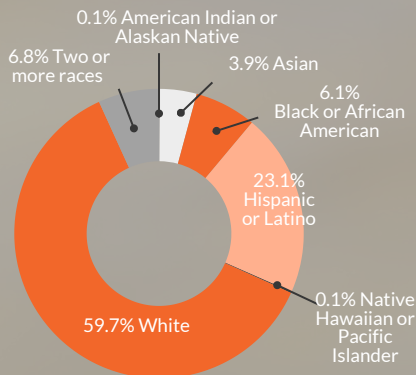
