High School and Middle School Snow Day Plans 2024-25

With potential of snow and ice in the coming months, snow days will come to mind. As done last year, please see the plans below should there be snow days in our future.

- While originally traditional snow days were not built into the calendar, as we analyzed the

- Students will have 5 school days to turn in the assignment.
- Teachers will continue to support students during the 5 school days to provide help if needed on the assignment.
