



Graduate-Level Semester Credit

Vallejo City Unified School District has partnered with the University of the Pacific (UOP) to provide an opportunity for participants in the Vallejo Induction Program to earn up to 6 graduate-level semester units annually. This offering is open to both current participants and individuals who have successfully completed the program from the 2020-2021 academic year onwards. These graduate-level credits, focused on professional development, can be utilized for salary advancement or state licensing purposes. Prior to enrollment, participants are advised to verify their eligibility with the relevant agencies.

Graduate-level professional development credit is not part of a degree program at Pacific. The credits awarded are primarily designed to be used towards salary advancement and state licensing requirements. Candidates seeking credit for such purposes are advised to check with the appropriate agencies and gain approval prior to registering.

IMPORTANT: While completing the Induction program qualifies VCUSD participants to earn graduate-level credits from UOP, it is important to note that if "VCUSD In-House Credits" have already been applied for a salary increase, UOP credits cannot serve the same purpose within Vallejo City USD. Nonetheless, these UOP credits remain valuable and can be redeemed for salary increments in other districts or used as a potential replacement for "VCUSD In-House Credits."
