WASA

WASA is a non-profit, **ALL-VOLUNTEER** organization formed for the purpose of conducting a youth soccer program in the Westerville area. WASA belongs to the Ohio Soccer Association, allowing it access to a wide range of resources.

- Team jerseys New each Fall
- Limited team size allows more playing time per game
- Field, goals, nets, lining, flags, maintenance & refs
- League awards & Tournament trophies
- Qualified referees

Jerseys are distributed in the Fall and used again for Spring. New players added in the Spring receive a team jersey. Replacement jerseys for returning players or a coordinator approved team change is \$15, payable at the time of registration.

Shin guards are required! Only plastic cleats may be worn, no metal cleats. Younger players may prefer tennis shoes. Coaches select short and sock colors. Players supply shorts, socks, shoes and shin-guards. For your child's safety, no earrings may be worn per USSF rules. To avoid tears, please plan ear piercings, and the 6-week healing process, around soccer season.

REC LEAGUES

Teams are **re-balanced** each Fall based on experience/skill level and random placement. Teams remain together Fall & Spring sessions after which they are again re-balanced going into the next Fall season. This has been proven to be the most beneficial to the development of a soccer player. Spring vacancies are filled from new applications or, numbers and coaches permitting, new teams may be formed.

AWARDS

U5, U6 & U7 are non-competitive, with emphasis on instruction and familiarizing the player with the sport, receiving participation trophies. U8 and U10 leagues receive participation trophies in a Spring "Festival Tournament". U12 leagues have traditional tournaments with first, second and participation trophies awarded.

MIDDLE SCHOOL

WASA sponsors Middle School rec teams for 7th & 8th graders. They compete with neighboring area leagues and travel locally to Columbus suburbs. They are governed by the Middle School Soccer Association (MSSA). We offer Boys & Girls teams, open to all skill levels. Each season ends with a tournament.

HIGH SCHOOL LEAGUE

WASA sponsors co-rec high school teams for students not playing Fall high school or Spring select/club. Team formation is an equal balance of boys & girls. Sunday afternoon games are for fun & fitness. Governed by High School Soccer Assoc. (HSSA).

ADULT LEAGUES

Open Co-ed, Coed 30+ & 40+, Women's 30+ & 40+

Adult leagues form their own teams for Spring, Summer & Fall. Individual sign ups can be placed. Emphasis is on fun & fitness. Contacts:

At the start of every soccer season, a free WASA refereeing class is offered. This five-hour introductory class, (two 2.5-hour sessions) allows you to ref only in WASA rec games.
