Test Security Enhancements: Students are required to provide their gender and a photo when registering for both the SAT and ACT. This information will be included on admissions tickets, test center rosters and high school reports. Students will upload (via the ACT and College Board website, mobile device, or mail) a recognizable head-and-shoulders photo of themselves when registering for these tests. Students must provide their high school code (100-146) when registering. Students must also bring their admissions ticket and acceptable photo ID on test day.

# **SunCoast Blood Center Scholarship**

High School Seniors are eligible to earn scholarship funds from SunCoast Blood Centers through donations of blood and/or volunteer hours with SCBC.

To apply students must:

- Complete an application form with essays
- Show proof of graduation in 2025

### **Elks Most Valuable Student Scholarship**

The Elks National Foundation will award 500 four-year scholarships to the highest-rated applicants in the 2025 competition.

- Any high school senior who is a citizen of the United States is eligible to apply.
- Applicants must be citizens of the United States on the date their applications are signed
- Male and female students compete separately.



2025 Most Valuable Student applications are due to the Elks Lodge closest to the applicant's home by **November 12, 2024**. Applicants will be judged on scholarship, leadership, and financial need. Applications must be submitted to the Elks Lodge closest to the student's permanent U.S. address. Applications must advance through local, district and state competitions to reach national judging. In late April, the 20 top finalists will participate in a Leadership Weekend in Chicago during which they'll interview with the national judges. These 20 finalists will be vying for two first-place awards of \$50,000; two second-place awards of \$40,000; and two third-place awards of \$30,000. The remaining 14 finalists will receive awards of \$20,000. The 480 runners-up will receive fifth-place scholarships of \$4,000.




# Florida American Legion Boys State



# Coolidge Scholarship - Juniors Only

The Coolidge Scholarship is a full-ride, four-year, merit scholarship that can be used at any accredited college or university in the United States. **Any high school junior** who plans to enroll in college in the fall of 2026 and is an American citizen or legal permanent resident is eligible to apply (current high school seniors are not eligible to apply). Winners may use the scholarship to pursue any academic major.

- A complete description of the scholarship's criteria, along with the online application and more information, is available at coolidgescholars.org
- NOTE: The application requires that candidates read President Coolidge's *Autobiography* and a few other readings and then write three essays. So begin the application early.
- Submission deadline is Wednesday, December 11, 2024 at 5 pm Pacific Time.

Students must request that their ACT scores be forwarded directly to the center by entering code "9999" as a reporting selection when registering for the test.

Edmunds Scholars, in addition to their academic abilities and intelligence, must have strong character and integrity along with the potential to be outstanding leaders. Intellectual distinction alone is insufficient for selection as an Edmunds Scholar.

Candidates for this outstanding scholarship program must meet the following minimum requirements:

- Secondary GPA of at least a 3.5 on a 4.0 scale (weighted GPA accepted)
- Must apply to Stetson University for admission first.
- Deadline for J. Ollie Edmunds Distinguished Scholarship is December 1, 2024

## **National Honor Society Scholarship**

The National Honor Society Scholarship application for 2024-2025 academic year is now open. The **deadline for applications is Thursday, November 26.** NHS will award 600 students with a scholarship!

1 National Winner: \$25,000 | 24 National Finalists: \$5,625 | 575 National Semifinalists: \$3,200

NHS Student members who meet the following criteria are eligible to apply for the NHS Scholarship this year. Applicant must be:

- ♦ A high school senior
- ♦ An active NHS member in good standing
- ♦ Currently enrolled at a school with an affiliated NHS chapter
- ♦ Planning to enroll at a postsecondary college or university in fall 2025



Eligible NHS senior members must first create an account with NHS by going to <a href="www.nhs.us/create-an-account">www.nhs.us/create-an-account</a>. IMPORTANT: When crating the student account, students should not use a school - issued email address. You will need to have access to this email after graduation

The application has three required components.

- 1. NHS Student Application
- 2. NHS Adviser Certification –NOTE: The deadline is during Thanksgiving Break, please plan ahead to get this certification completed BEFORE you go on break as well as asking for the recommendation.
- 3. One recommendation form (must be completed by an individual who can speak to the applicants demonstration of and commitment to the pillars of NHS)
