



International Baccalaureate Passing Conditions for the IB Diploma

The goal for all IB Diploma candidates is to fulfill all the requirements necessary to earn the IB diploma. The IB Diploma will be awarded to a candidate provided all the following requirements have been met.

1. The candidate's total diploma points are 24 or more.
2. The candidate has gained 12 points or more on HL subjects (for candidates who register for four HL subjects, the three highest grades count).
3. CAS requirements have been met.
4. There is no "N" awarded for Theory of Knowledge, the extended essay or for a contributing subject.
5. There is no grade E awarded for Theory of Knowledge and/or the extended essay.
6. There is no grade 1 awarded in a subject/level.
7. There are no more than two grade 2s awarded (HL or SL).
8. There are no more than three grade 3s or below awarded (HL or SL).
9. The candidate has gained 9 points or more on SL subjects (candidates who register for two SL subjects must gain at least 5 points at SL).
10. The candidate has not received a penalty for academic misconduct from the Final Award Committee.

Failure to meet any of the conditions above is known as a *failing condition*. **In order to remain enrolled as an IB Diploma candidate from their junior year to their senior year, students must not be in danger of a failing condition.** Therefore, students may not continue in the IB Diploma Programme if any of the following conditions exist at the end of the junior year:

1. On-going CAS work has **not** been maintained throughout the junior year.
2. The candidate has earned the grade of F in one or more subject.
3. All required IB internal or external assessments have **not** been completed.
4. The Theory of Knowledge exhibition was **not** completed.
5. The final drafts of the History Investigation and the English Lit HL Essay have **not** been submitted.
6. All required drafts of the Extended Essay have **not** been submitted.
7. The candidate was found to be in violation of the IB Honor Code on an assessment that is to be submitted to the IB (internal or external assessment).

By signing below, I acknowledge understanding of the requirements to earn the IB Diploma. I also acknowledge that I will not be allowed to continue in the IB Diploma Programme if I have any failing conditions at the end of the junior year.
