

eLearning Days with Microsoft Teams

Students and Families



On an eLearning Day, students will engage in synchronous instruction via Microsoft Teams. Links to Teams meetings have been shared by teachers on their Canvas and Seesaw course homepages.

- Similarly to Zoom, Microsoft Teams offers video conferencing features, enabling students to attend virtual classes, engage in discussions, and interact with their teachers and peers through video.
- Microsoft Teams supports screen sharing, which comes in handy for presentations, sharing educational resources, or presenting projects.
- Moreover, the platform enables the use of breakout rooms and chat messaging for communication with teachers and classmates.

Student Access

- Using [Classlink](#), students should navigate to Seesaw or Canvas to join their Class Teams Meeting from any device connected to wifi.
- To access the synchronous class, students in grades 5-12 should go to [Canvas](#), while students in grades PK-4th should go to [Seesaw](#).
- Simply click on the provided link to enter the teacher's live class session.
- You might be directed to a waiting room, and the teacher will admit you shortly.
- Users of Seesaw may have to find the link in the "messages" section.
