
November Highlight: Updated SHAKA-GRAM Program

We are happy to announce an update to our SHAKA-GRAM program, which is a great example of our Learning & Nurturing Environment pathway, as well as our Family pathway. Our SHAKA-GRAM celebrates our Student Learning Expectations (SLE's) which are skills, abilities, and behaviors we require our students to routinely practice during their enrollment at HFCA.

The mnemonic S-H-A-K-A is used to help our students recall the main themes of each SLE, including Self-Evaluator, Habitual Learner, Active Christian, Kind Citizen, and Appropriate Communicator.

We updated the program after we received thoughtful feedback during our last Coffee Chat with Admin. We are excited to recognize all recipients each week (no more random drawings) and provide more information detailing why your child earned a SHAKA-GRAM.

Each SHAKA-GRAM certificate will be retuned to the recipient so that you can celebrate this achievement at home as well!
