School Goals

- By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, all grade levels will increase their Approaches score from 49% to 52%, Meets from 24% to 25%, and Masters from 7% to 8% on STAAR Reading Assessment.
- By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, all grade levels will increase their Approaches score from 48% to 51%, Meets from 16% to 17%, and Masters from 7% to 8% on STAAR Math Assessment.
- By the end of the 2024-2025 school year, based on BOY to EOY Amplify and MAP Assessments, 72% of our 2nd graders will meet or exceed one year's growth.

ATTENDANCE MATTERS

The Texas attendance rules say that a student has to be in a class at least 90% of the time if they want to be sure to get credit for that class.

At Candlewood Elementary, we track attendance daily, weekly, quarterly, and yearly. Grade levels, classrooms, and students are recognized for their attendance.
