- Alexander II Math & Science Magnet School has the distinction of being the first elementary magnet school in the state of Georgia.
- Besides having opportunities to exceed in math and science, students at Alexander II enjoy developing their skills in multimedia (broadcasting), music, physical fitness, and multiple co-curricular activities including Lego Robotics, Quiz Bowl, and competitions in math, music, and media.
- Alexander II received a 5-Star climate rating (2018), earned the recognition level of PBIS Distinguished School (2021-2024), designated a Title I Distinguished School in 2017-2018, 2018-2019, 2022-2023, and recognized as a Title I Reward School in 2022-2023.
- Historically, Alexander II has been a three-time Georgia School of Excellence recipient, received the Silver Award of Excellence in Education through the Department of Education in 2005, 2006, and 2008, and was named a National Blue Ribbon School of Excellence through the United States Department of Education twice in a decade (2006 and 2015).
- Alexander II is one of 74 schools in Georgia to be STEM certified by the Georgia Department of Education (2020).
