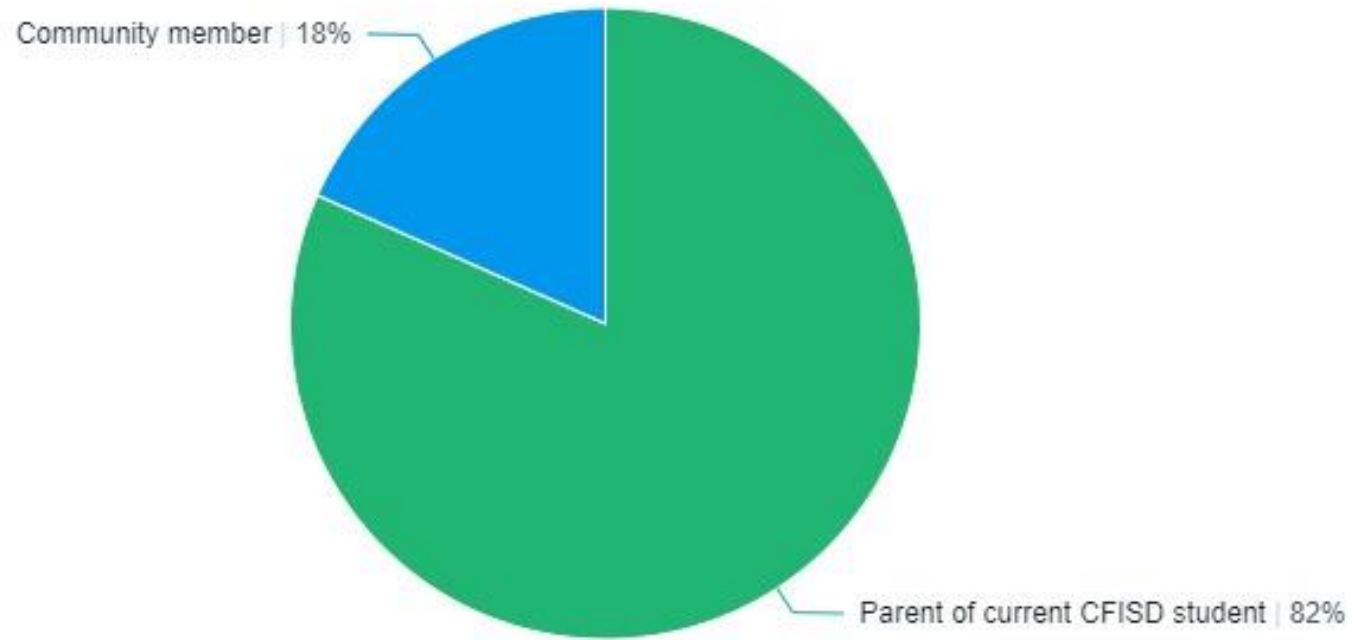


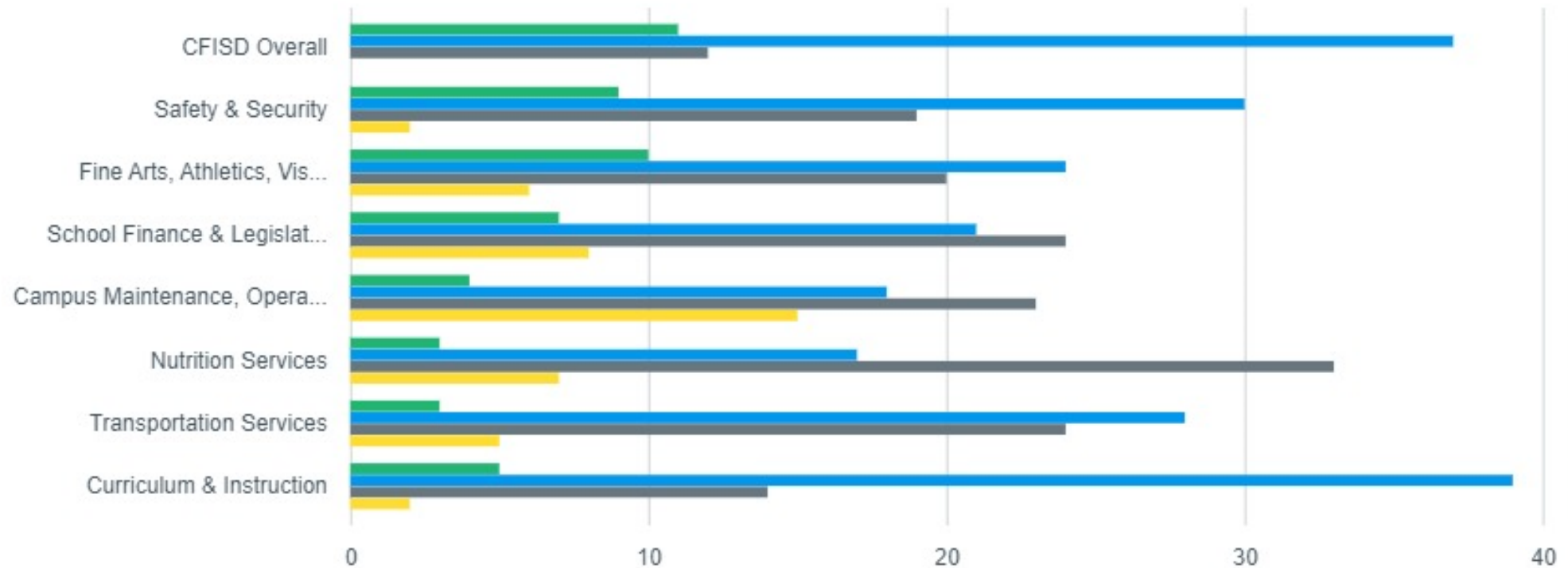

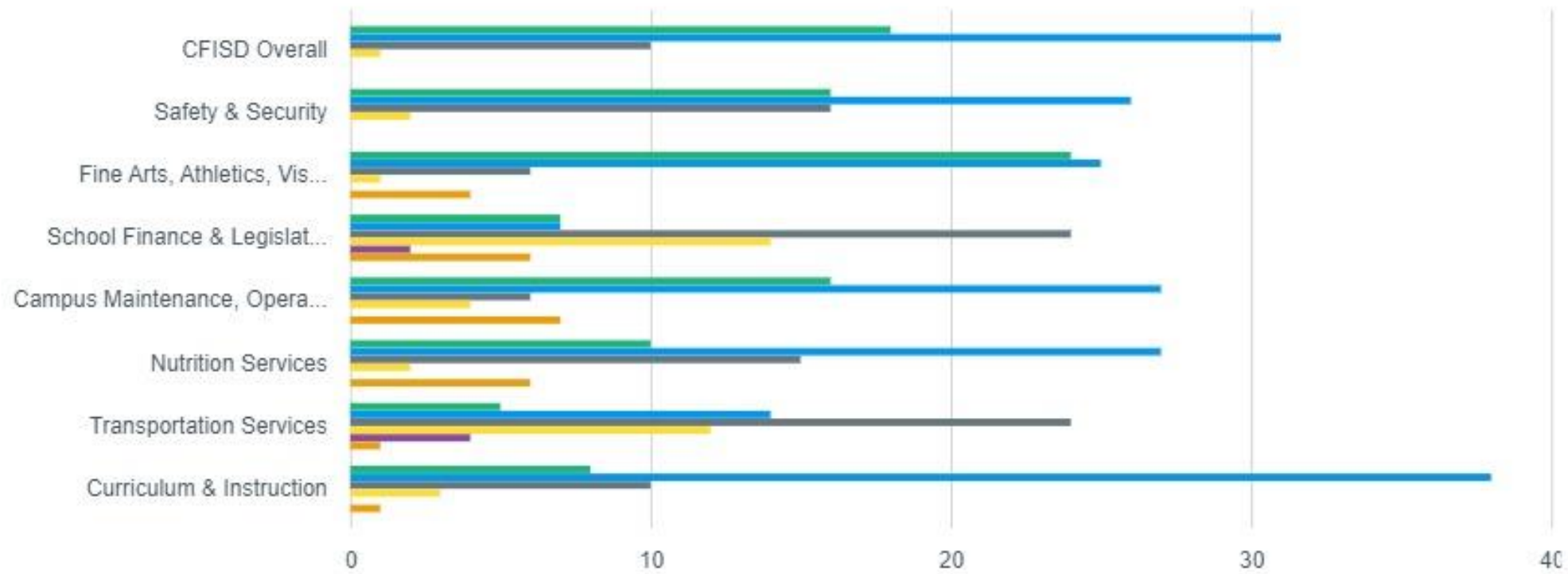

Please rate how knowledgeable you are about the following areas in CFISD:

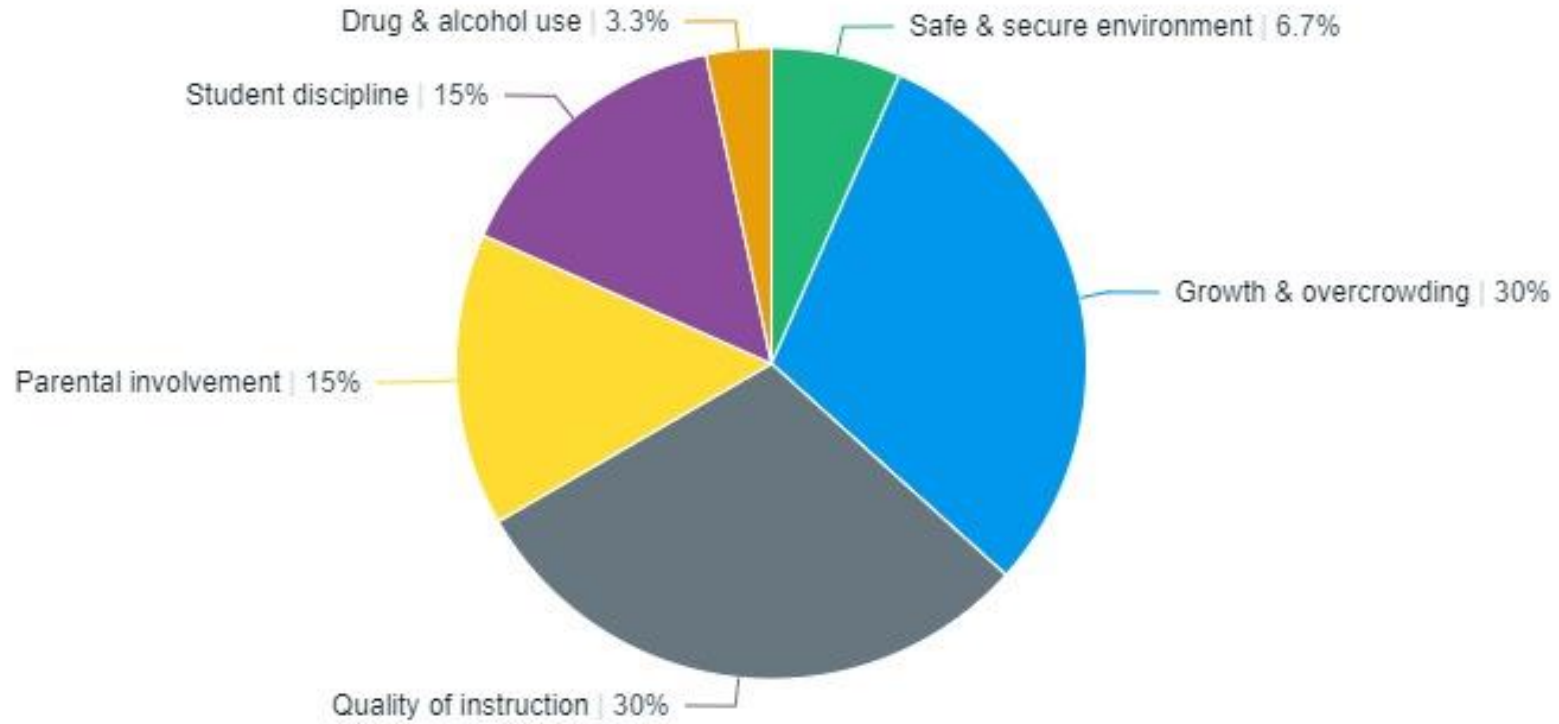


Please rate whether you have a positive or negative impression of the following as they relate to CFISD:

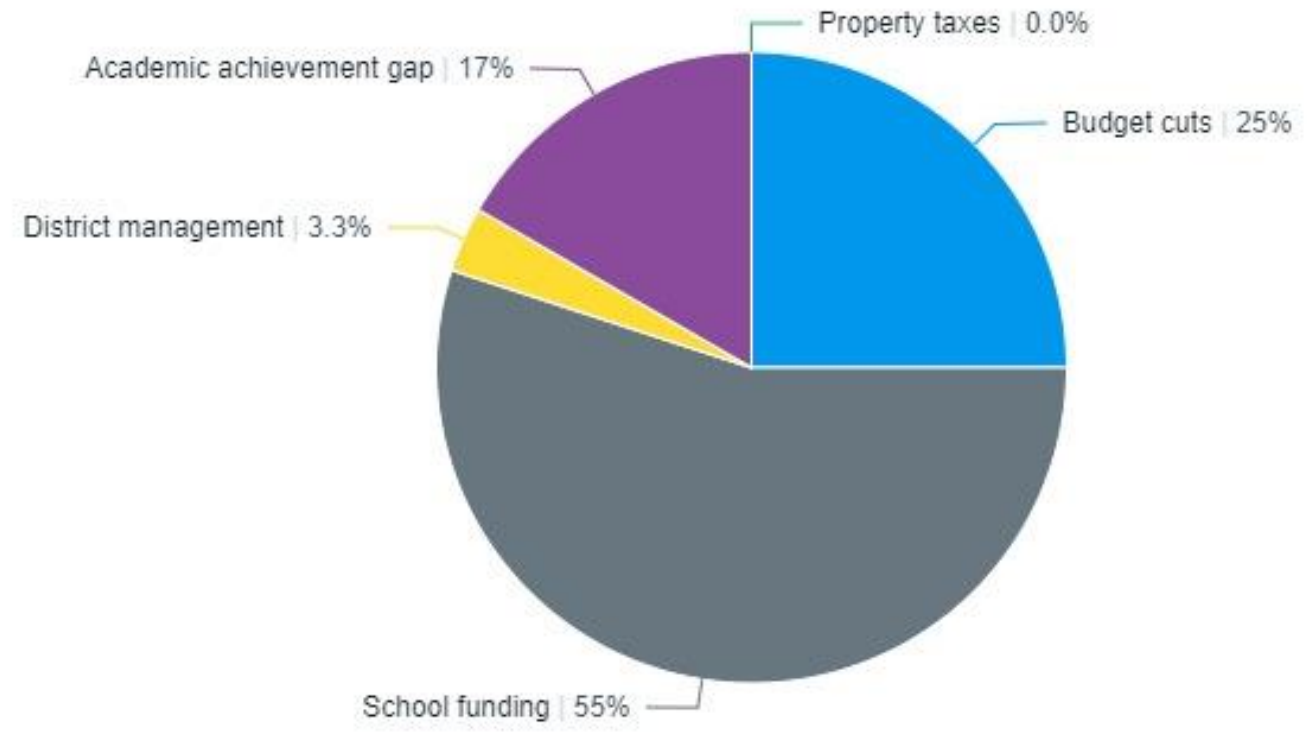

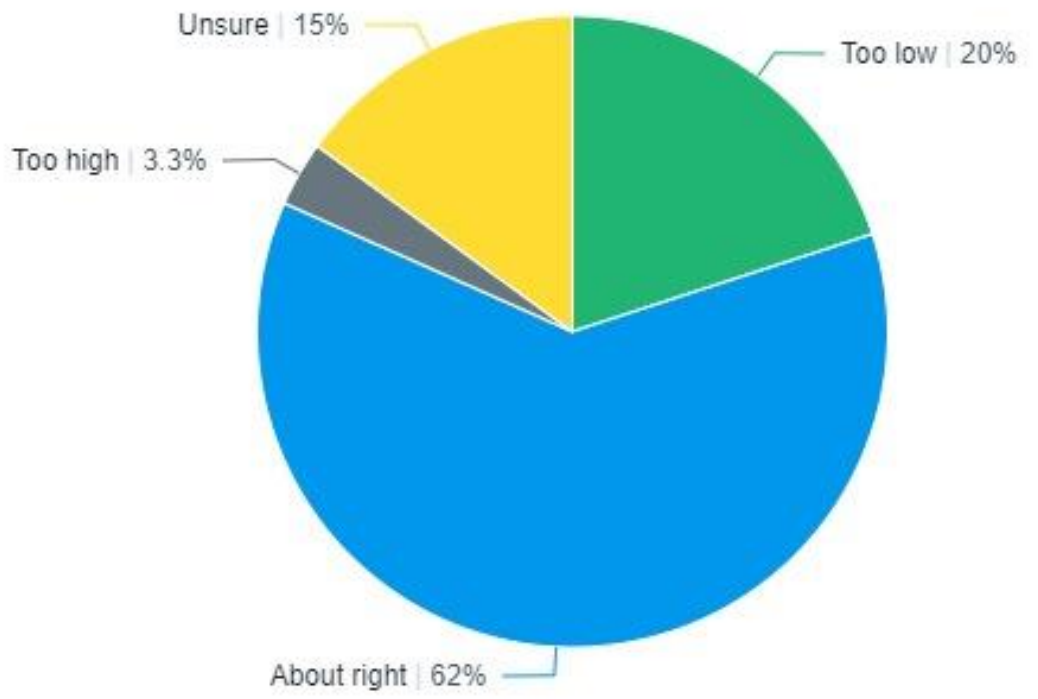
Which is the biggest challenge (from this list) facing CFISD?



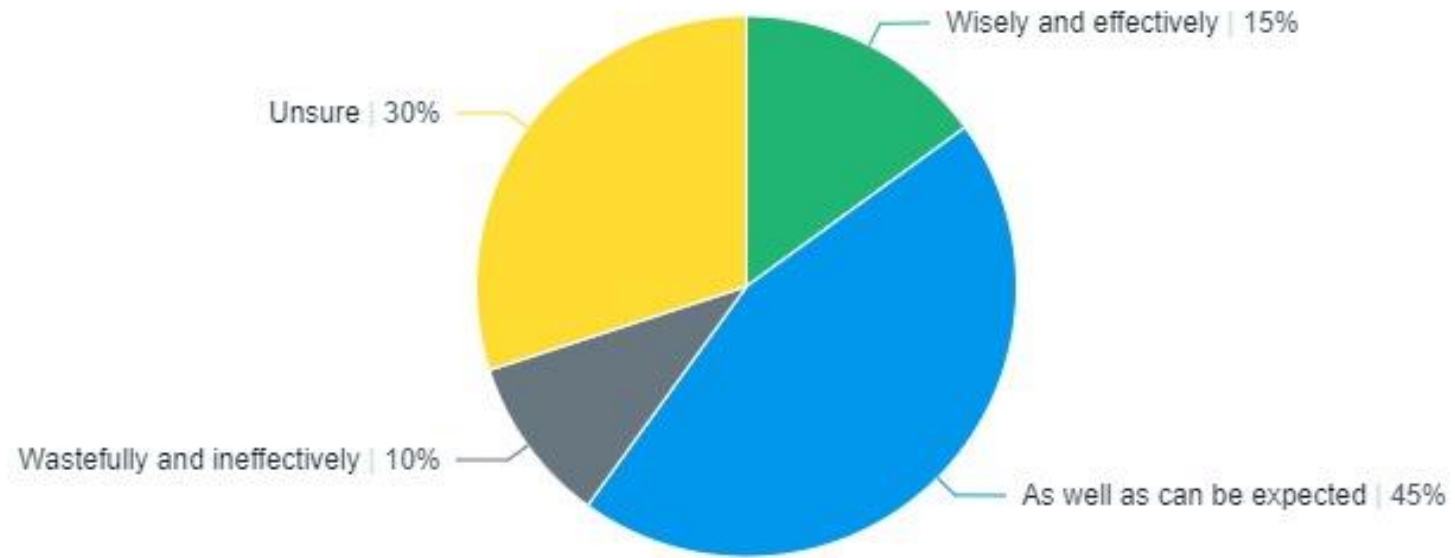
Which is the biggest concern (from this list) facing CFISD?



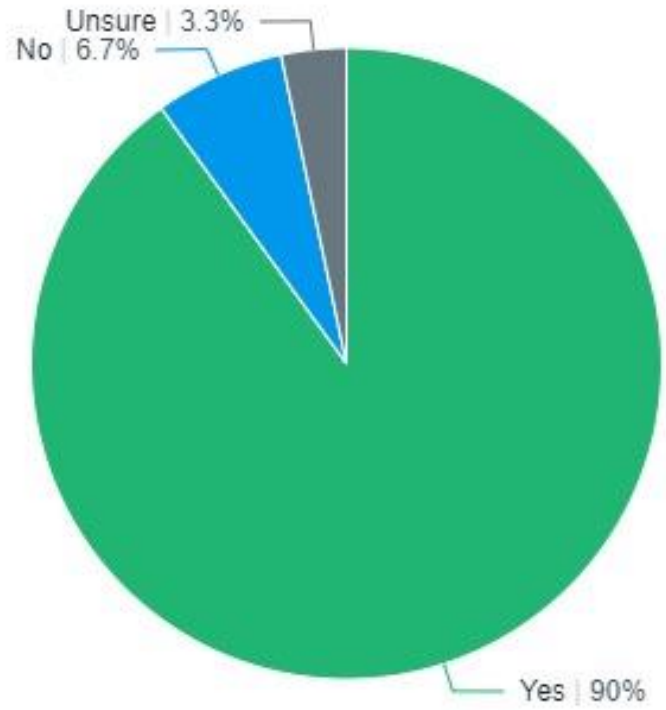
In general, do you think the overall academic standards in CFISD are ...



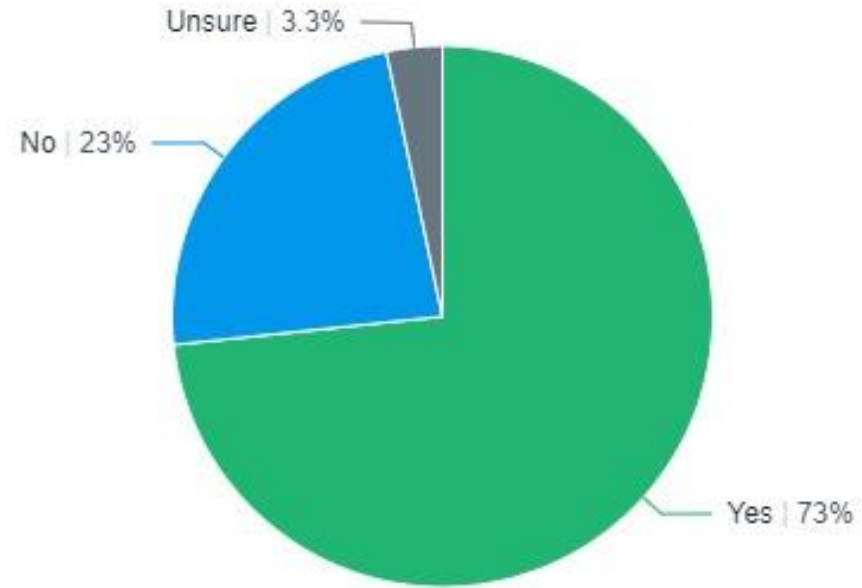
Which of the following best describes your opinion of how CFISD manages money ?

Be transparent and communicative

Educate and expose its members to CFISD processes and explain how state mandates and laws affect

Just be inclusive and receptive to feedback, as well as being transparent

What can we do to ensure Leadership CFISD is a positive and productive experience?

Allow space for critical feedback and strategy building from both tenured and nontenured participant

Set better expectations re time required to participate, 5 hour days are difficult

Provide pre-meeting material so we can come ready to participate and learn

Make sure the time is relevant. Asking 9-2 is a large commitment.

Improve the communication to the community. This will require providing more integrated activities.

Continue to inform and provide transparency by holding these type of engagements.

Transparency communication keeping negativity out

Open discussions

Bring members into the district "behind the scenes" to help everyone have a full understanding.

Stay on task and on time, provide real information and not fluff, invite feedback

Listen to feedback, answer questions and no secrets!

Transparency communication keeping negativity out

Put out all the information both good and bad so we have the full picture and can help

Listen with an open mind and take suggestions and try to implement things as you can

Open and honest communication!

Ask for feedback after each meeting and allow the responses to help navigate future meetings.

Communicate clearly, foster an open and positive environment, encourage respect for all opinions.

Listen and implement change for community concerns.

True engagement and solicitation of feedback. Provide experiences to gain better understandings.

Maintain the position that it is as educational as possible for the participants

Provide a clear plan of what will be on the agenda for each session

Be an open book and communicate with us

Be open and forthcoming with information.

Continue to have productive sessions like today to teach us about the district.

Listen to opinions, be transparent, educate.

Give the good, bad and ugly without bias

Provide factual/ unbiased information along with opportunities to learn at the school level.
