CREDIT SYSTEM

- A minimum of 24 credits is required for graduation.
- One credit is awarded for each year-long course successfully completed in grades 9-12. One-half credit is awarded for semester-long courses.
- One-half credit may be awarded for students who are transferring out of OIS if one semester has been completed.
- Transfer credits will be received as a P/F and will not be factored into the GPA unless a student is transferring from another NICS/Oasis network school. Partial credit may be issued as transfer credit.
- Under certain circumstances, such as transfer students, EV, Fine Arts, and Online course requirements may be waived at the discretion of the principal.

GRADE POINT AVERAGE (GPA)

- GPA includes all courses taken at OIS and other accredited NICS/Oasis sister schools including our online partner, Northstar Academy (NSA).
- Transfer grades from other schools not in the NICS/Oasis network are not calculated in the student's GPA.
- Grade level GPA is based on the average of a student's final stored grades for each grade level year and is reported on a student's transcript.
- Cumulative GPA is also reported on a student's transcript and is the average across all grades.
- Grade points are awarded based on the OIS grading scale with AP courses granted one additional point per credit in the computation of GPA.



SCHOOL CALENDAR:

- There are 178 school days
- Divided into two semesters
- School Year August 14th, 2024 June 13th, 2025
- Class of 2025 Graduation Date: June 7th, 2025
- OIS students typically take 6-8 classes a year (with 0-2 study hall blocks depending on course load).
- Average school day is divided into 6 80 minute blocks with a two-day rotation, and 2 40 minute daily blocks.
- Enrichment period runs daily for 40 minutes . During this time students participate in Hubs (small group enrichment), Advisory, Clubs, or Quiet Zone (learning resource time).
