PENNSYLVANIA HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES SCHOLARSHIP: For graduating seniors and legal residents of PA, with a minimum 3.0 GPA, planning to attend any four year college in PA, and demonstrating leadership and community service (Two recipients/Amount varies)

PENNHOSA FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP FUND: for affiliated, paid HOSA chapter members by January 1 with financial need (Multiple recipients/Amount varies)

LEADER SCHOLARSHIP FUND: For legal resident of Cumberland, Dauphin, Lancaster, or York county who has been accepted into HACC Harrisburg Campus LPN program as a full-time student to study in the LPN Program (Number of recipients varies/ up to \$5,000)

SAMUEL L. ABRAMS FOUNDATION: to help deserving graduates and faculty members of the Harrisburg and surrounding School Districts further their educations and obtain undergraduate and graduate degrees. (multiple winner/amount varies)

LEON LOWENGARD SCHOLARSHIP: for students attending Harrisburg City Public Schools and surrounding districts with a minimum GPA of 2.5; must be an undergraduate student. Preference will be given to students who are of Jewish faith (Multiple recipients/Amount varies)

RAY S. SHOEMAKER SCHOLARSHIP: for students attending Harrisburg City Public Schools and surrounding districts with a minimum GPA of 2.5; must be an undergraduate student (Multiple recipients/Amount varies)

DAVID M. KLEPPINGER FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP: *For a Senior from Hershey High School who plans to attend Penn State Main Campus or Florida Gulf Coast University to study Political Science, Pre-Law, Finance, Nursing or General Liberal Arts.*

LEADER SCHOLARSHIP FUND: For legal resident of Cumberland, Dauphin, Lancaster, or York county who has been accepted into HACC Harrisburg Campus LPN program as a full-time student to study in the LPN Program (Number of recipients varies/ up to \$5,000)

DRANE AND STEELE MUSIC FUND: For students from Adams, Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Fulton, Juniata, Lancaster, Lebanon, Montour, Northumberland, Perry, Snyder, and York Counties, studying classical music composition, teaching, and performance (Multiple recipients/Up to \$5,000)

G. THOMAS BALSBAUGH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP: for graduating seniors of high schools in Dauphin County, planning to attend a four year college or university (One recipient/Up to \$1,000)

HARRY N. AND MELVA A. DERICKSON SCHOLARSHIP: for students who are residents of Dauphin, Cumberland, and Perry Counties, for study in preparation for medical or dental school, nursing, physical therapy, other medical related fields, or engineering (Multiple recipients/Amount varies)

HOMEBUILDERS ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP FUND: for students who have graduated from a high school in Dauphin, Cumberland, or Perry Counties with plans to attend an institution of higher learning or trade school. Preference is given to students in the building industry or related fields (Number of recipients varies/Amount varies)

KENNETH G. ROBINSON, APR MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP: for PA undergraduate students who are civic-minded and require tuition assistance to continue their education in the Communication and Public Relations fields. (\$1000)

JACK AND EDNA MAY YOST SCHOLARSHIP FUND: for graduating seniors from Dauphin or Cumberland County high schools, with a minimum 2.5 GPA, attending any two or four year college or university; preference will be given to children of postal employees and students who plan to major in nursing or education (Multiple recipients/Up to \$5,000)

ACES FOUNDATION FUND: for graduating seniors from high schools in Cumberland, Dauphin, and Perry Counties, with a GPA of 2.5 or higher, planning on attending a school of higher education, and whose study shall be of business focus (management, administration, finance, actuarial sciences, etc.); also includes students studying trades such as cosmetology or HVAC with the intent to own their own business (Multiple recipients/Amount varies)

EASH-POTTER SCHOLARSHIP FUND: the scholarship will support students committed to improving the campus and community climate for LGBTQ people (Number of recipients varies/Amount varies)

ELY-WAIN SCHOLARSHIP FUND: for graduating seniors from a high school in Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Lebanon, or Perry Counties with plans to pursue a field of study leading to a “green career” including to Environmental Science and Sustainable Technology (Number of recipients varies/Amount varies)

GROVE FAMILY FUND #2 — HACC: for students attending Harrisburg Area Community College as a full-time or part time student. Minimum GPA of 2.0 or higher (Two recipients/Amount varies)

ROBERTA L. HOUP T SCHOLARSHIP FUND: for students from Dauphin, Cumberland and Perry Counties, studying nursing (Multiple recipients/Up to \$2,000)

LEON I. LOCK AND BARBARA R. LOCK SCHOLARSHIP FUND: for graduating seniors and graduates within the last five years of any high school in Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Lebanon, or Perry Counties, who will attend HACC to study nursing (Multiple recipients/Up to \$500)

MCINROY-SHEFFER PEOPLE TRUST FUND: for graduating seniors studying elementary education, culinary arts, communications, fundamental business operations, hands-on trades, nursing, management, or e-business (Multiple recipients/Up to \$2,000)

ROYER FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP FUND: The Royer family have established this fund to help their employees, their children or grandchildren gain additional education to help them succeed in life. This scholarship is available for trade, 2 or 4-year post high school continued education for full or part-time students. (Up to 4 awards/ \$1000-\$2500)

BIG 33 ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP FUND: for students in PA planning to attend a technical school or accredited college or university following high school graduation. (Multiple winners/ up to \$2,000 each)

BEISTLE COMPANY SCHOLARSHIP FUND: for students who are legal dependents of full time employees of the Beistle Company; second preference may be given to students graduating from Shippensburg High School; third preference may be given to students graduating from high schools within a 30 mile radius of Shippensburg (Number of recipients varies/Up to \$1,000 per year for up to four years)

JEM GROUP DIVERSITY IN CONSTRUCTION SCHOLARSHIP FUND: For minority groups or young women going into construction related fields.-Business, Trade Careers, Engineering, Architecture, Interior Design. Must have a 3.0+ GPA and reside in Dauphin, Cumberland or Perry County. (2 winners, up to \$5000)

DR. GEORGE H. AND MRS. HETTIE S. LOVE “LOVE OF LEARNING” SCHOLARSHIP FUND: An eligible student would have financial need and will be entering the education field. The scholarship is designed to support Black students and students of color entering the education profession.

CONRAD SIEGEL “NUMBERS MATTER” COMMUNITY SCHOLARSHIP FUND: for graduating high school seniors pursuing a math, actuarial science, business math, or finance major at a four-year college/ university. They must be a resident of Dauphin, Cumberland, Perry, Lancaster, Lebanon, or York County, be a member of an underserved, minority population of the community and have financial need. (Multiple winners / up to \$5,000 each)

ANIL AND NEEMA THAKRAR FAMILY FUND : for students from Cumberland, Dauphin, and Perry Counties with a GPA between 2.0-3.0 with plans to study math, science, a medical profession, or engineering (One recipient/Amount varies)

THAD G. GAYMAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP FUND: For seniors from Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Lebanon, Perry and Northern York Counties who plan on studying Automotive Technology and attending a 2- or 4-year college, university, or trade school

MARY SACHS MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP: for graduating female high school seniors in Cumberland, Dauphin, Perry, or Lancaster Counties with plans to study fashion, fashion design, retailing, entrepreneurship, or business (Multiple recipients/Amount varies)

WALTERS SERVICES, INC. FABE & BEVERLY WALTERS SCHOLARSHIP FUND: Applicants must be children of employees under the age of 26, or must be a seasonal employee under the age of 26, with plans to attend college, university, or a trade school as a full-time or part-time student. (Number of recipients varies/Amount varies)

DR. FRANCIS J. VIOZZI MEMORIAL EDUCATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP FOR ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES: for graduating seniors from any Dauphin or Lebanon County high school with plans to attend a four-year institution of higher education. The student must have a concentration in science related to environmental conservation (biology, wildlife management, environmental studies, engineering, etc.) (One recipient/Up to \$1,500)

NICK PANTALONE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP: For students graduating from high schools located in the following counties: Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Lebanon, Perry and Northern York County (Dillsburg Area). Students must have at least a 3.0 GPA. 1 award up to \$2500

GARY D. RADINE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM: for dependent children of a Delta Dental employee attending a two- or four-year accredited college as a full-time student with a minimum GPA of 3.0 and participating in extracurricular activities, work experience, and community service (Two recipients/\$5,000)

LIPPERT –SIZEMORE SCHOLARSHIP FUND: The PFLAG-Greater Harrisburg developed this scholarship to recognize outstanding persons from Central PA for their involvement with the LGBTQ+ community. Must have a GPA of 2.7+ (1 award/\$1000-\$1500).

UNIVERSITY CENTER OF HARRISBURG SCHOLARSHIP FUND: For graduating high school seniors with a 2.0+ GPA or greater. (up to \$2500)

CENTRAL PA ARCHITECTS FOUNDATION FUND: Students who are present or former residents of one of the following Pennsylvania counties: Adams, Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Fulton, Juniata, Lancaster, Lebanon, Montour, Northumberland, Perry, Snyder, or York, and currently enrolled in an architecture degree program. <https://aiacentralpa.org/cpaff-scholarship-application/>

MATCHING AWARD OPPORTUNITIES

AES/PHEAA's PATH Program: Scholarship recipients are eligible to have their awards matched on a dollar-for-dollar basis by AES/PHEAA's PATH ("Partnerships for Access to Higher Education") Program. PHEAA may grant matching funds to scholarship recipients who are enrolled in an approved Pennsylvania college or career school as an undergraduate student on at least a half-time basis, who are a Pennsylvania state grant recipient and who demonstrate financial need. Students must also be a resident of Pennsylvania, not in default on any educational loans, maintain academic progress, and not be considered an incarcerated student. The match provides last-dollar support for tuition and fees. *Scholarship funds used for reimbursement of textbook purchases are not eligible for a PATH Program match.* The scholarship recipient's information is submitted to PHEAA by TFEC staff.
