	 Campaigning in the public school by School Board candidates or supporters of individual candidates is prohibited, except that organizations may sponsor all-candidate forums for public information purposes. No Board candidate may request that students or employees contribute or work for their re-election. This does not prohibit such persons from initiating contact outside of school/work hours and volunteering, as described in Policy 4018. 	
	Posting or Distributing Campaign Materials	
	 The Board prohibits the posting or distribution of campaign materials associated with School Board elections on district property with the following exceptions: Candidates may post up to 3 campaign signs per building between May 1 and the day of the election. Campaign materials may be posted and distributed in a school rented for a campaign meeting or being used for an all-candidate forum. Such materials may not be posted until after the school day has ended and must be removed at the end of the meeting. Campaign materials may be used as classroom teaching aids in a non-partisan lesson or discussion. 	
	 Campaign Announcements Board members running for re-election may not make announcements concerning re-election during a Board meeting other than during the Public Comment portion of the meeting. Statements made during Public Comment must conform in duration, location of the speaker, and use of district equipment or facilities to the normal Public Comment guidelines. The Board President or designee may publicly announce the names of all candidates for the School Board, but may make no comments concerning qualifications or incumbency. 	
Responsibility	The Superintendent shall ensure that all candidates for the Board of Education shall be given a copy of this policy. The Board shall monitor current members and new candidates to ensure compliance.
