Professional Staff All professional positions shall be established by the Board which shall approve the broad purpose and function in accordance with state law and regulations and a statement of job requirements. The Superintendent shall have a job description prepared and maintained for each position. All applicants for professional positions must meet licensure requirements of the state. Classified Staff The Superintendent shall have a job description prepared and maintained for each position. All new classified staff shall serve a probationary period in accordance with collective bargaining agreements or District regulations. This applies to former employees who are rehired or employees promoted to new positions. The Superintendent is authorized to accept the resignation of any classified staff member to be effective at a time the Superintendent designates. 	
Responsibility	The Superintendent and Board leadership shall be responsible for compliance.
